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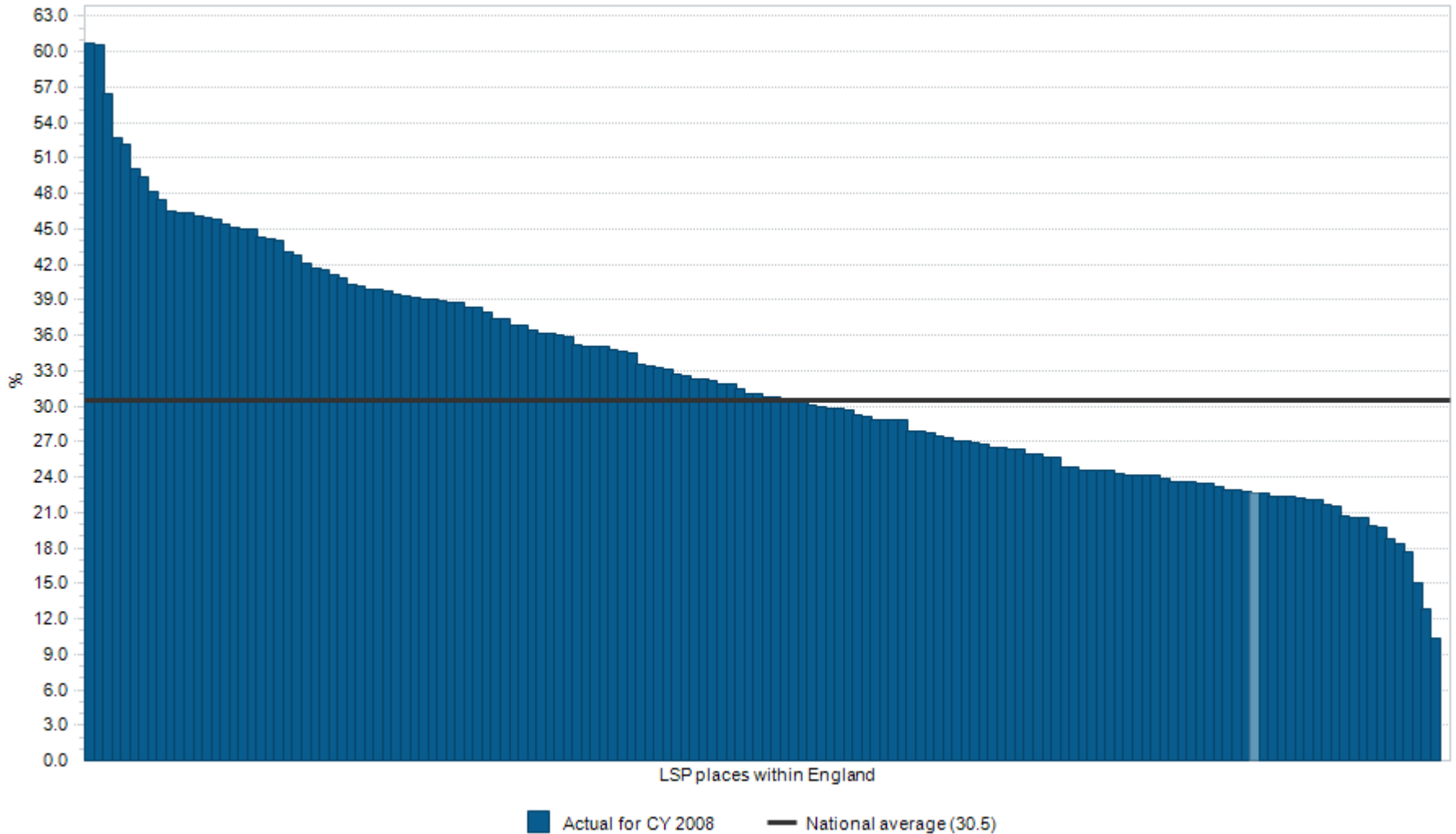
NI 041 - Perceptions of drunk or rowdy behaviour as a problem - Essex LSP (22) - CY 2008





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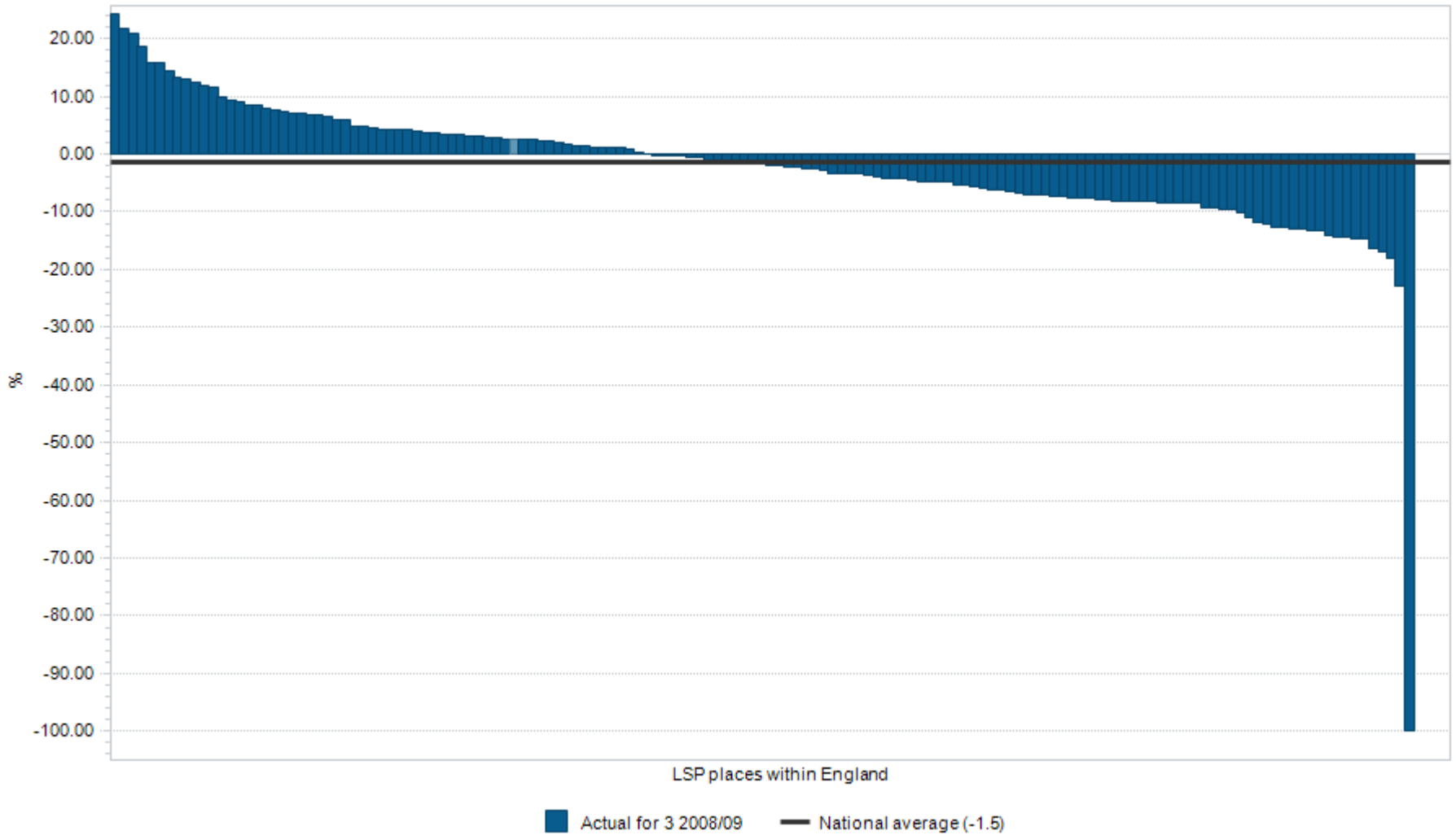

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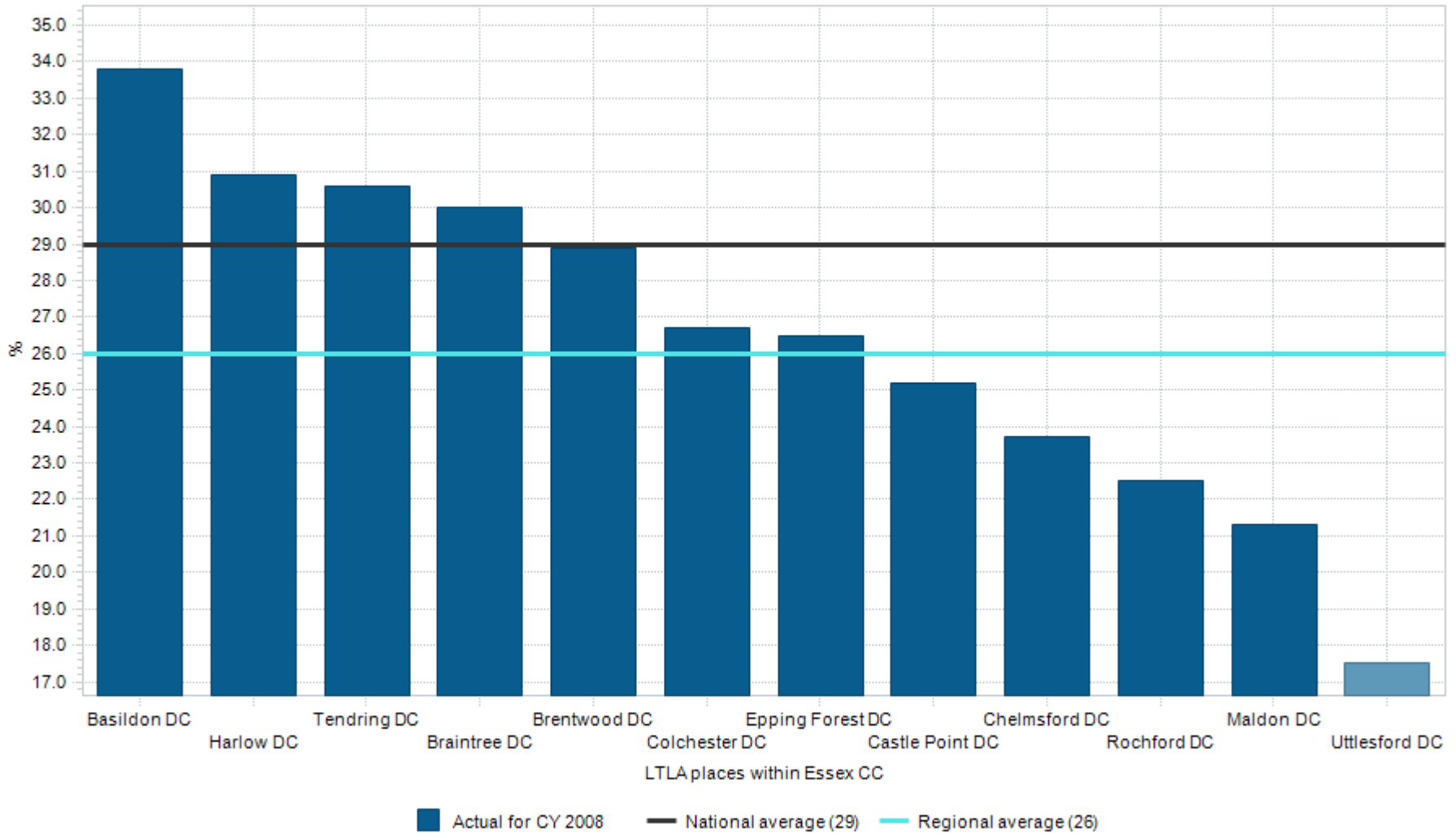
NI 039 - Rate of Hospital Admissions per 100000 for Alcohol Related Harm - Colchester DC (22UG) - FQ4 2008/09





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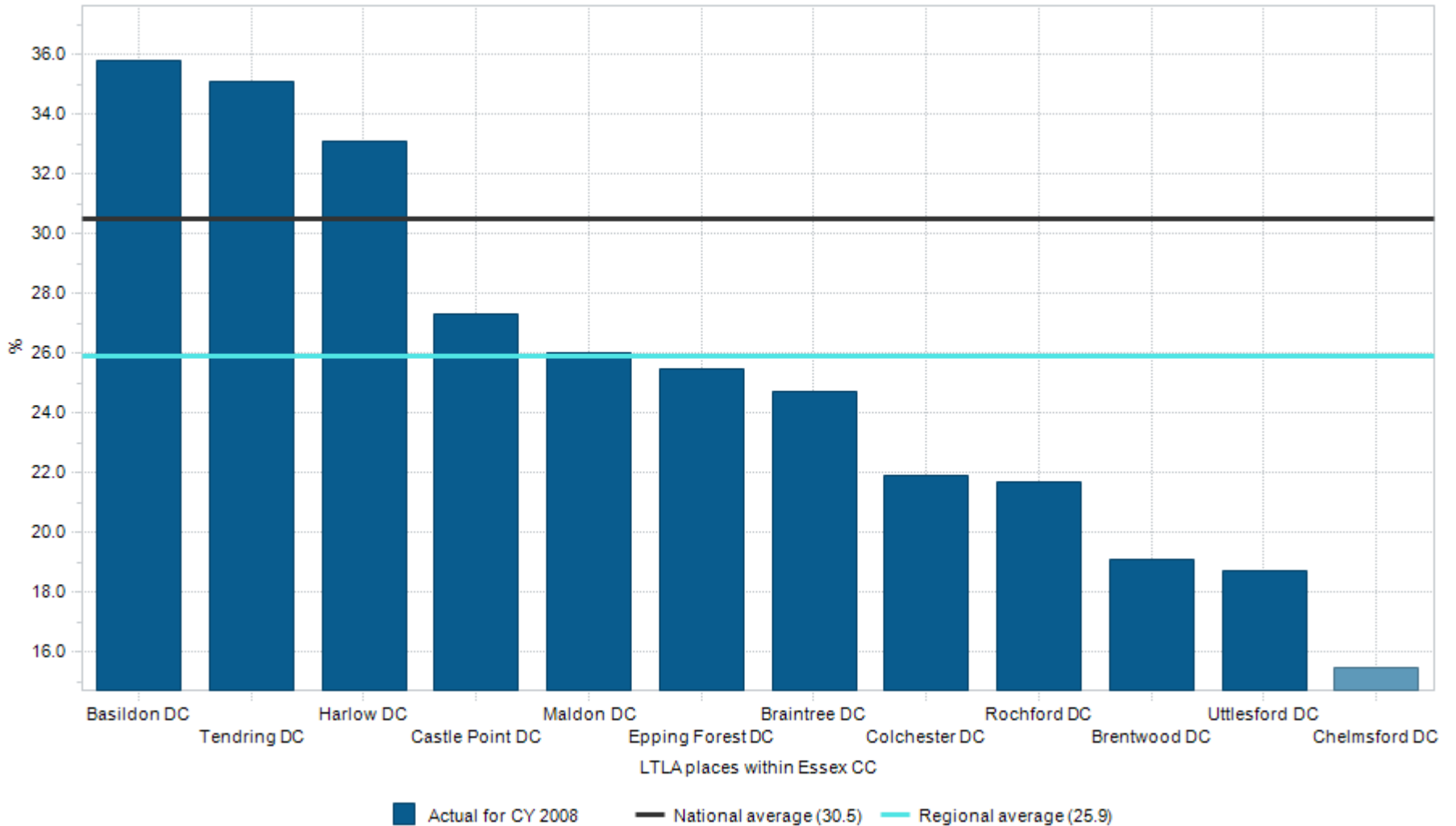

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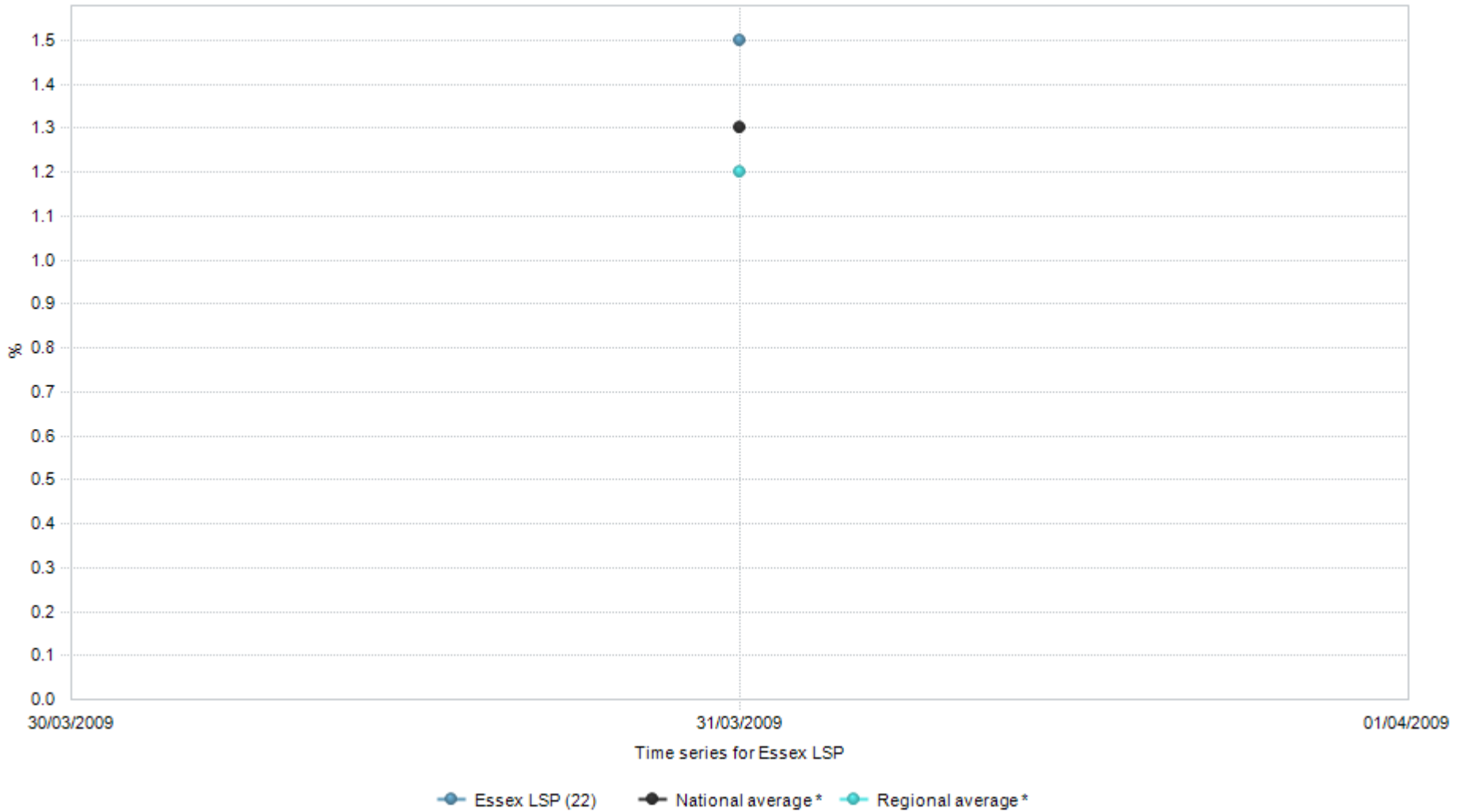
NI 018 - Adult re-offending rates for those under probation supervision - Essex LSP (22) - 3 2007/08 to 3 2008/09





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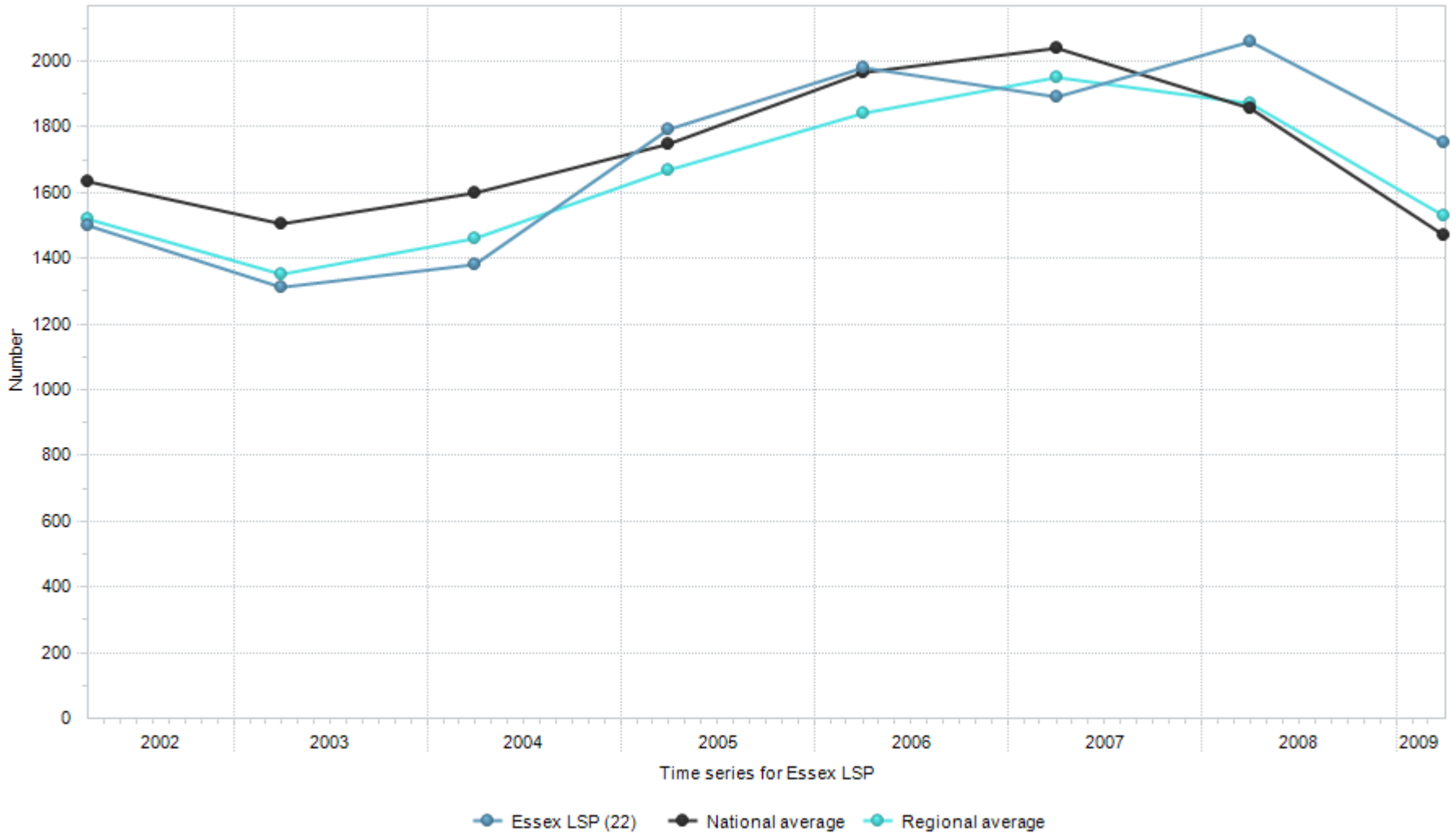
