



## **MALDON DISTRICT COMMUNITY SAFETY PARTNERSHIP** **STEERING GROUP**

### **Membership:**

- Each Partner Organisation is able to nominate one member.
- Up to three Maldon District Councillors are eligible for membership to ensure a strong democratic representation.
- The Partnership Manager Community Safety plus any other post holders directly funded by the Partnership.
- Chairmen of each Sub Group.

### **Purpose of Group:**

The Steering Group provides practical advice in translating our policy into action and acts as a critical friend in relation to action by RAGS, Sub Groups or working parties.

To co-ordinate and support the work of the Local Strategic Partnership on Community Safety issues by undertaking the role of task group.

### ***Terms of Reference***

1. To receive reports from the Chairman of the Sub Groups and the Partnership Manager - Community Safety on the progress in achieving the Community Safety Strategy and secondary objectives.
2. To report to RAGS on the progress of the Strategy and secondary objectives.
3. To act as a critical friend in relation to the activity of the Partnership in successfully achieving its objectives.
4. To make recommendations to RAGS in relation to activity, strategy or consultation that the Steering Group considers desirable to achieve the Strategy or secondary objectives.
5. To undertake projects to meet the aspirations within the Sustainable Community Strategy (SCS).
6. To provide quarterly reports to the LSP on the progress in meeting the key community safety challenges within the SCS.
7. To provide advice to the RAGS on the levels of actual or perceived crime and disorder experienced by the members organisation.

8. To provide advice to the RAGS on the community safety related activity made by the members' organisation.
9. To meet as regularly as deemed necessary by the group, and at least twice per year.
