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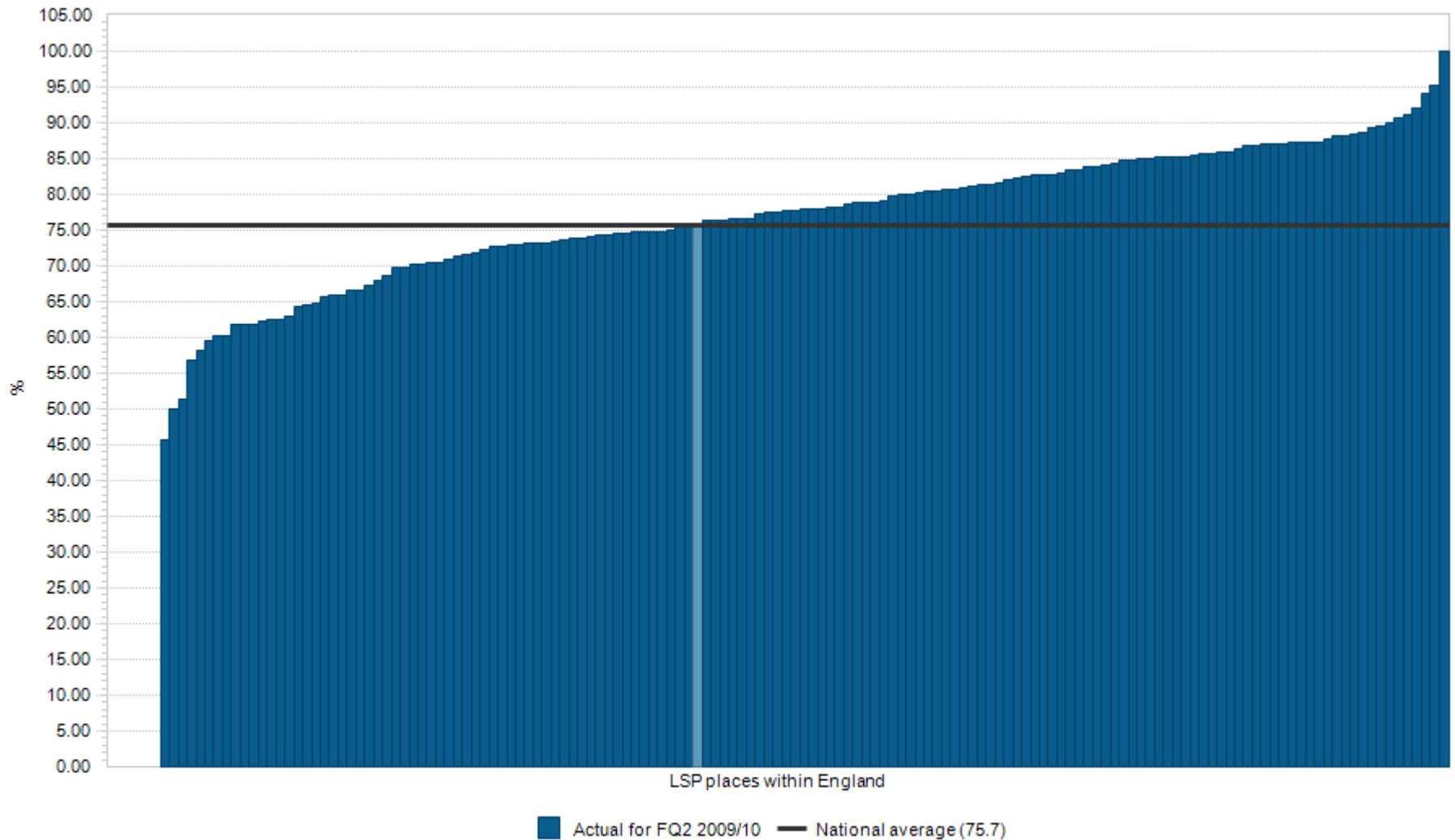
NI 139 - The extent to which older people receive the support they need to live independently at home - Essex LSP (22) - CY 2008





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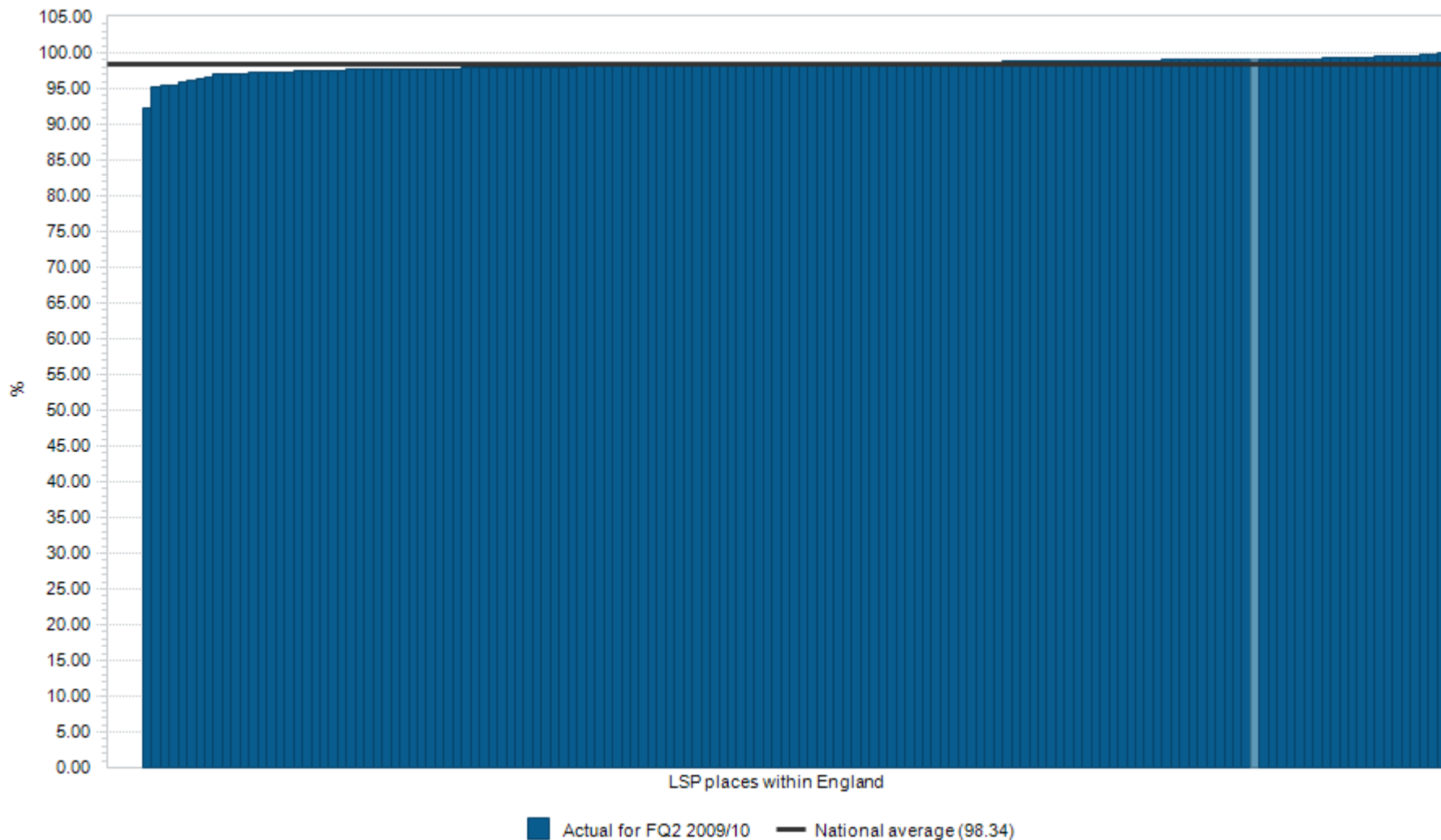
NI 141 - Percentage of vulnerable people achieving independent living - Essex LSP (22) - FQ2 2009/10





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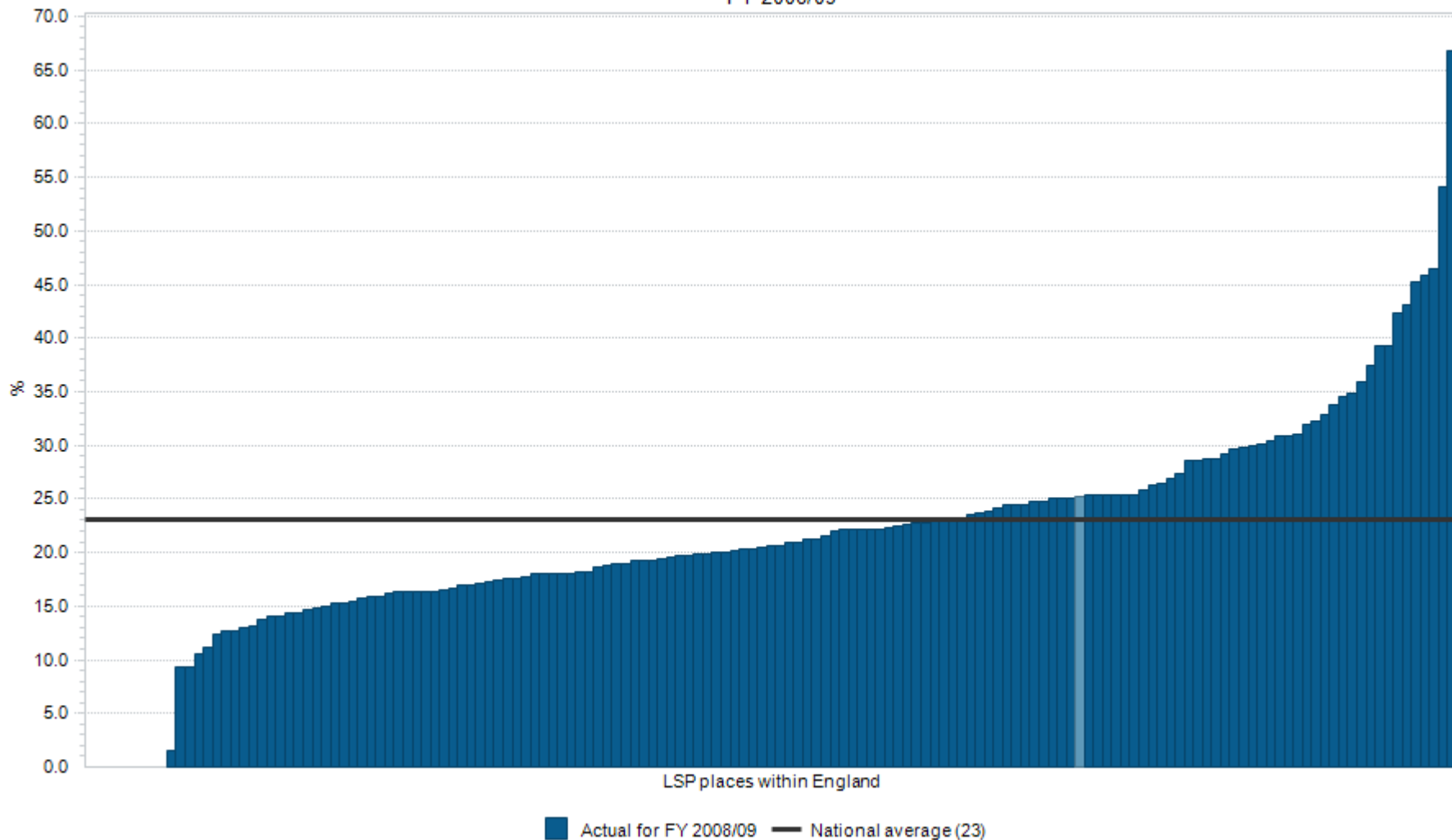

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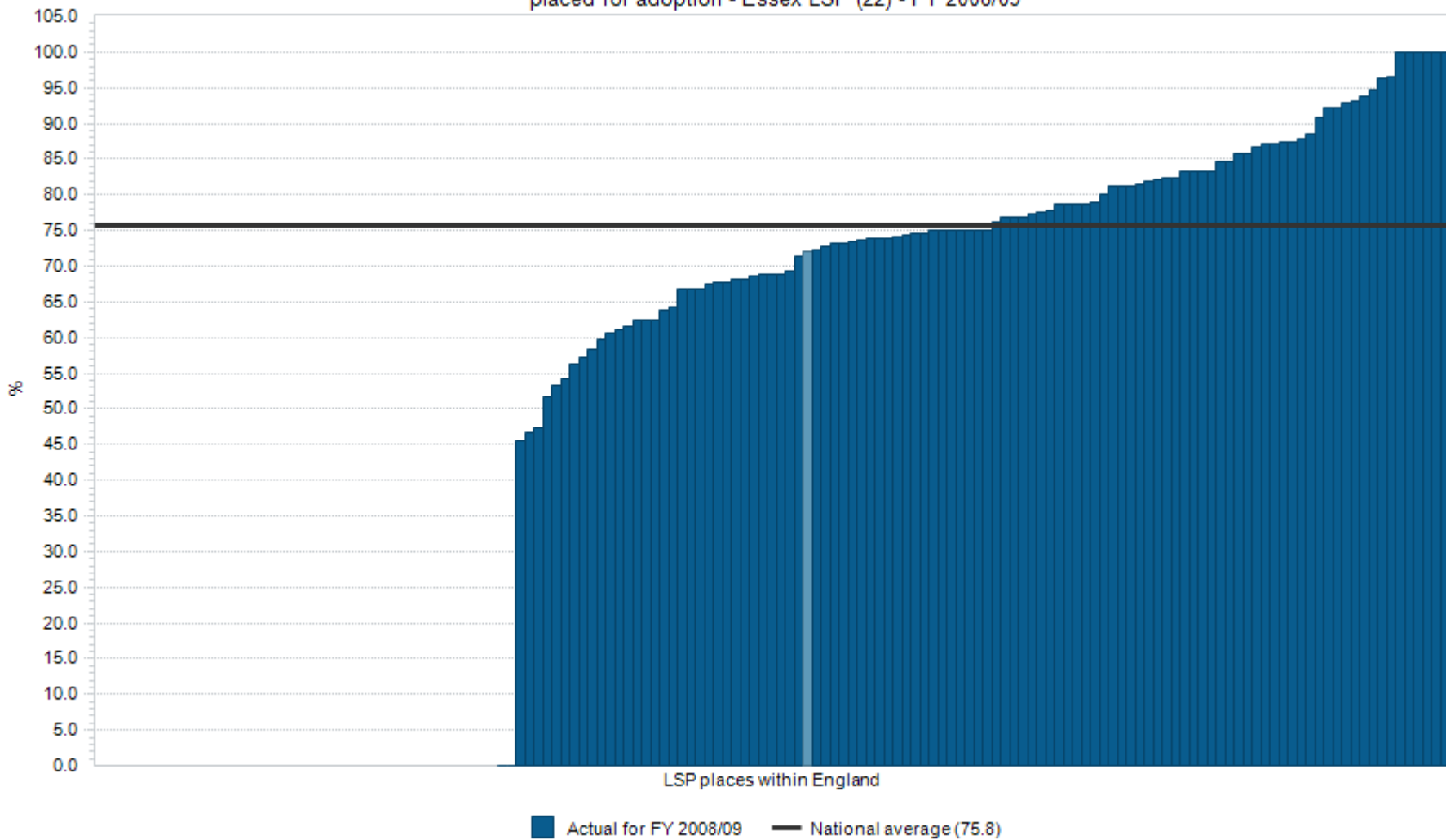
NI 060 - Percentage of core assessments for children's social care that were carried out within 35 working days of their commencement.

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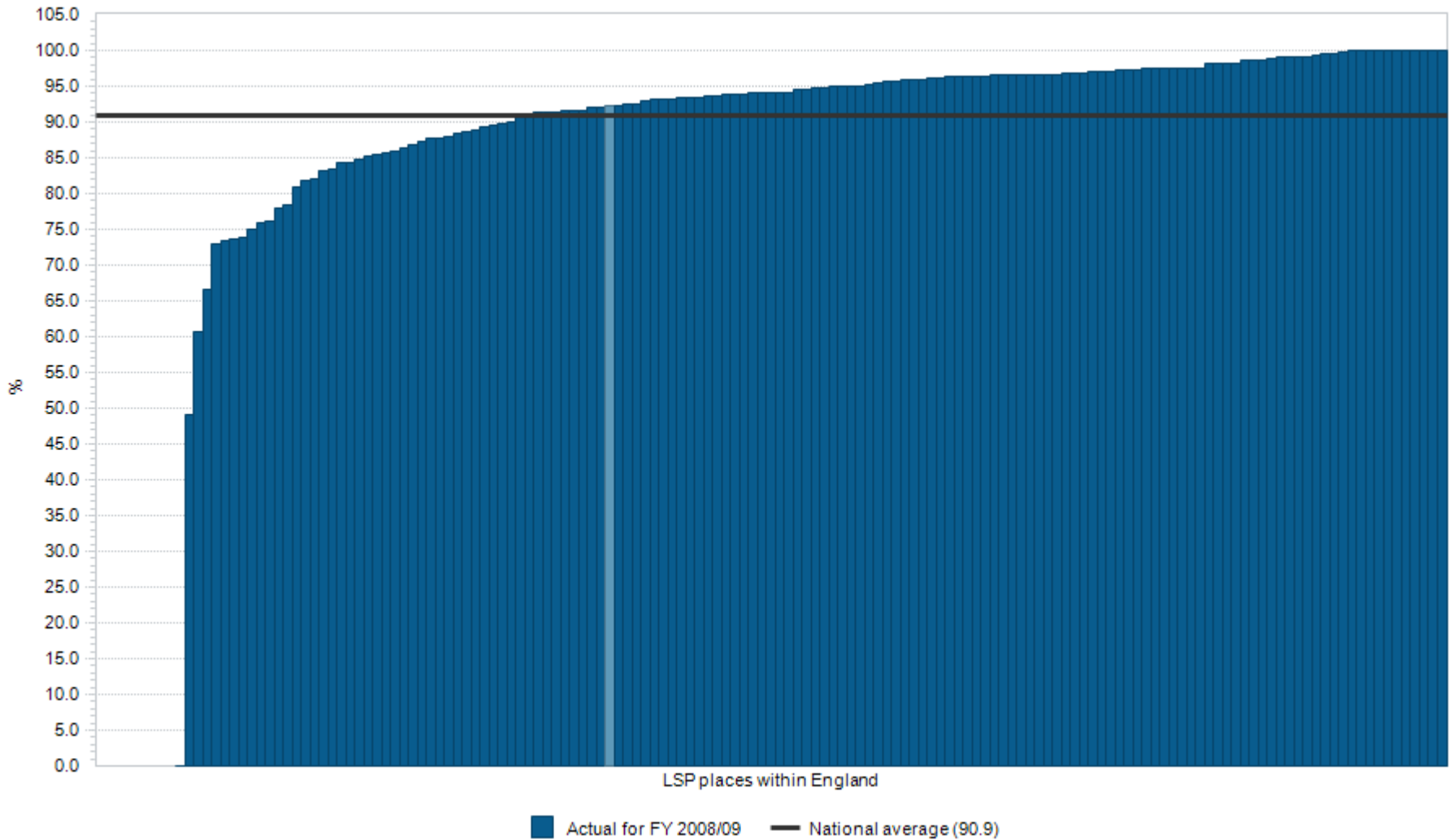
NI 065 - Percentage of children becoming the subject of Child Protection Plan for a second or subsequent time - Essex LSP (22)

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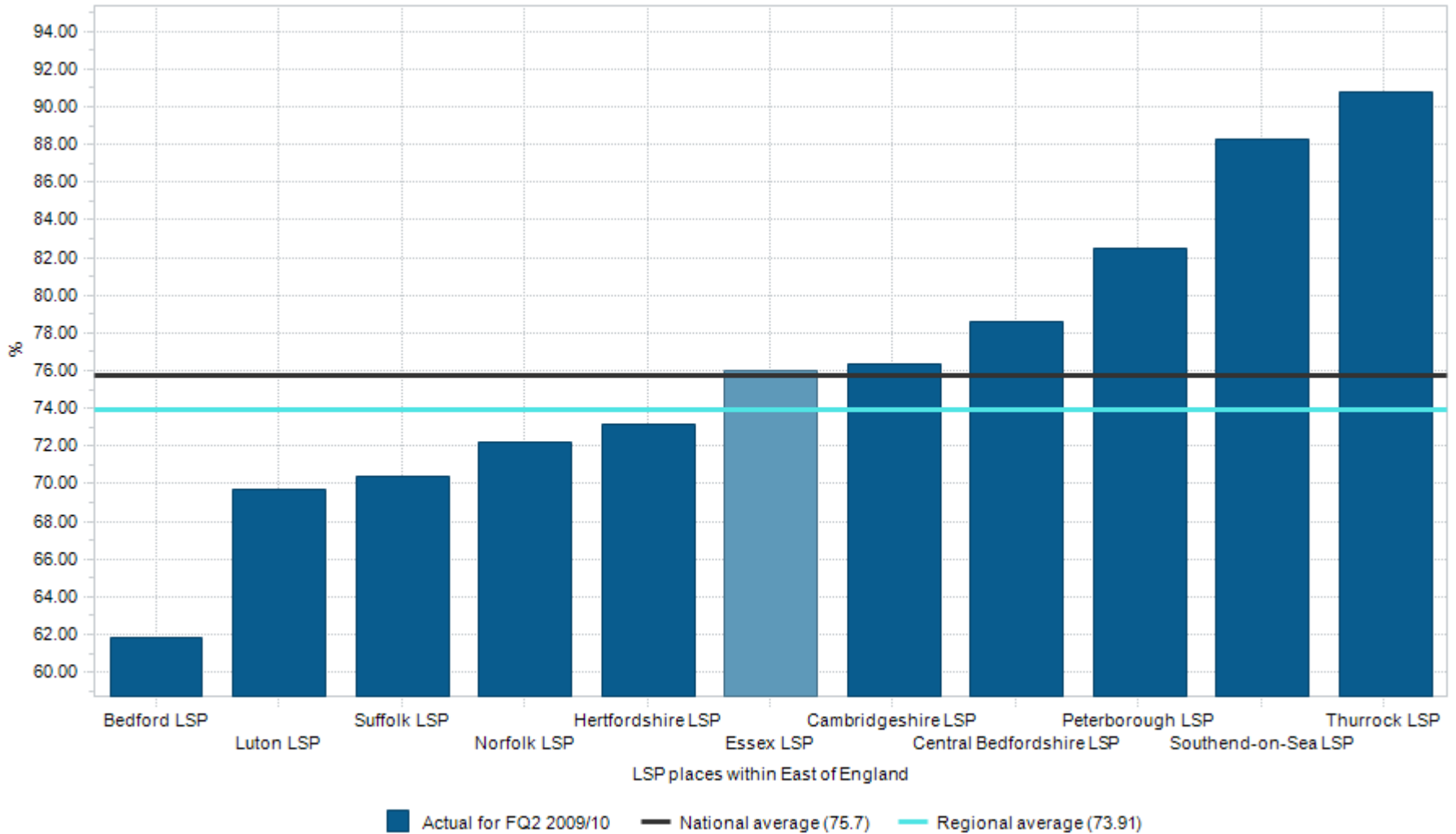
NI 139 - The extent to which older people receive the support they need to live independently at home - Essex LSP (22) - CY 2008





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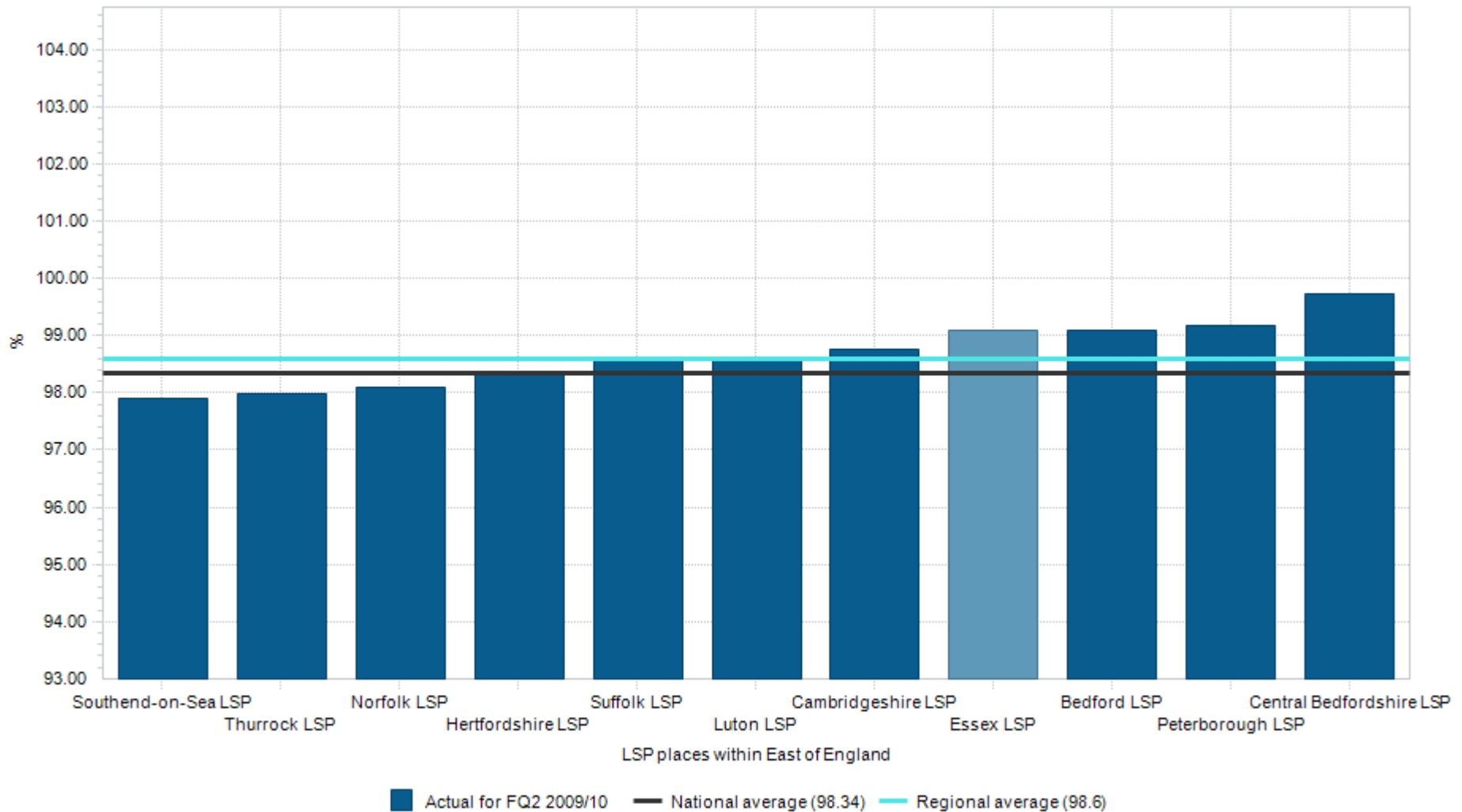

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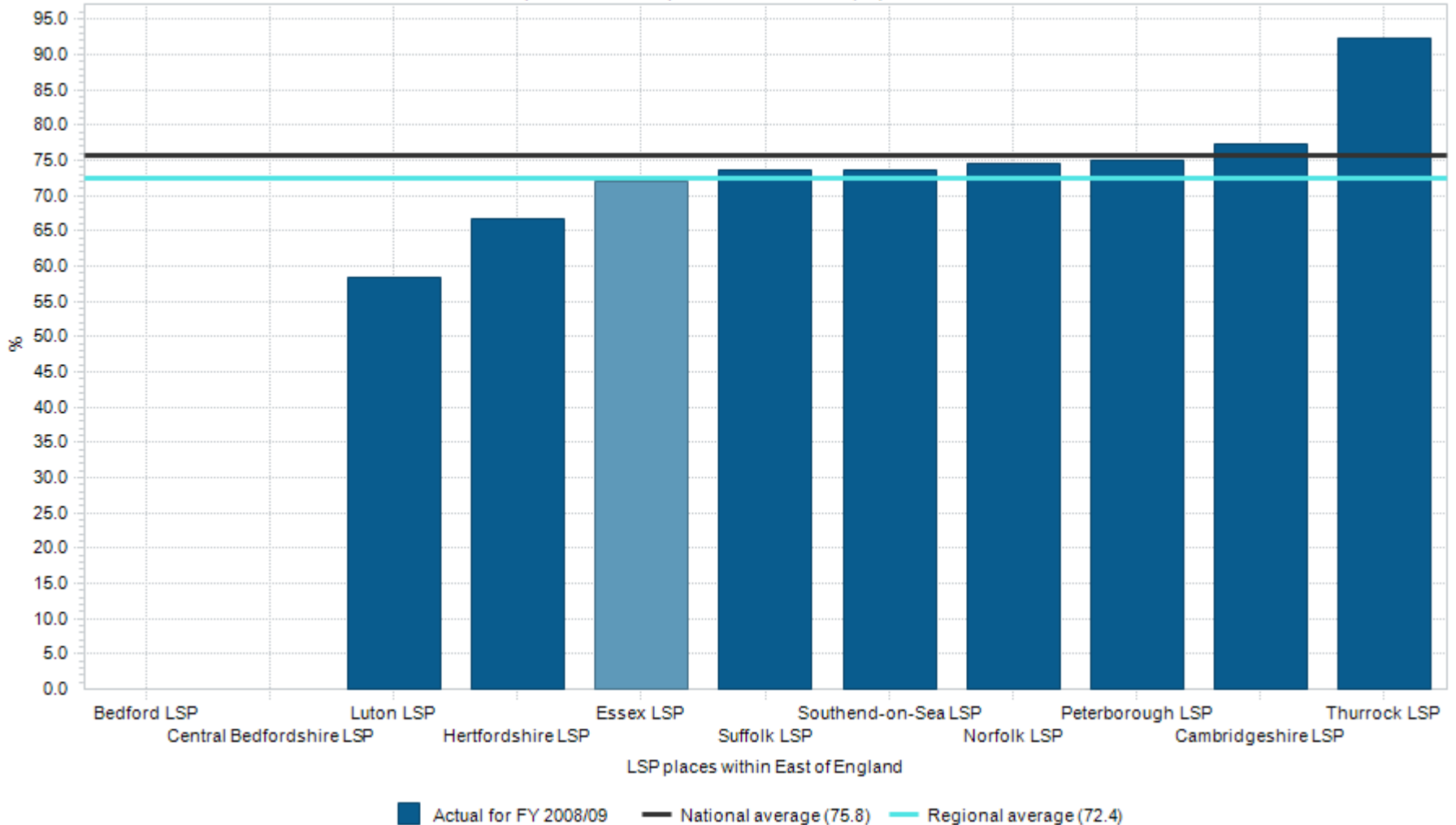
NI 060 - Percentage of core assessments for children's social care that were carried out within 35 working days of their commencement.

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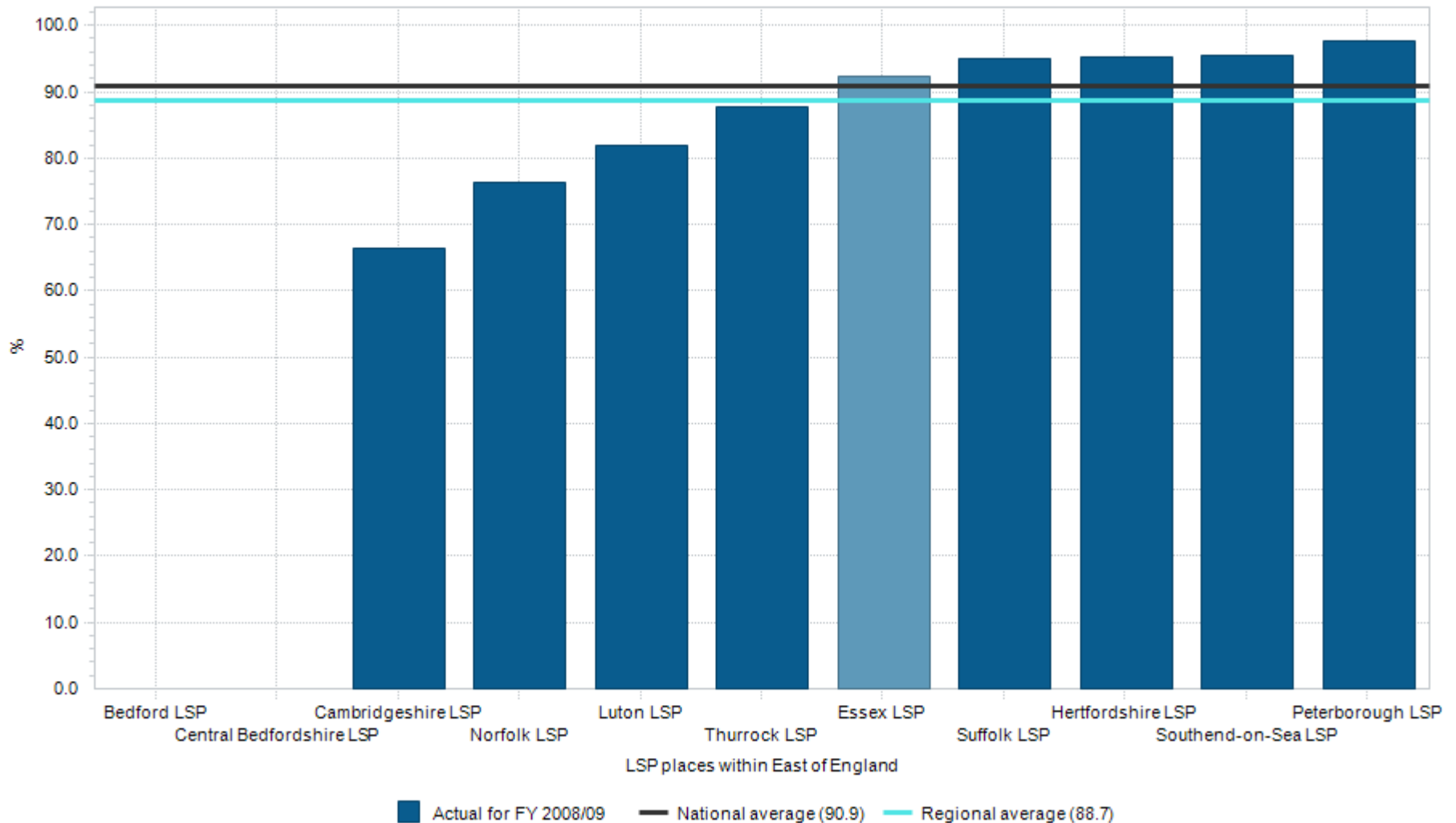
NI 065 - Percentage of children becoming the subject of Child Protection Plan for a second or subsequent time - Essex LSP (22)

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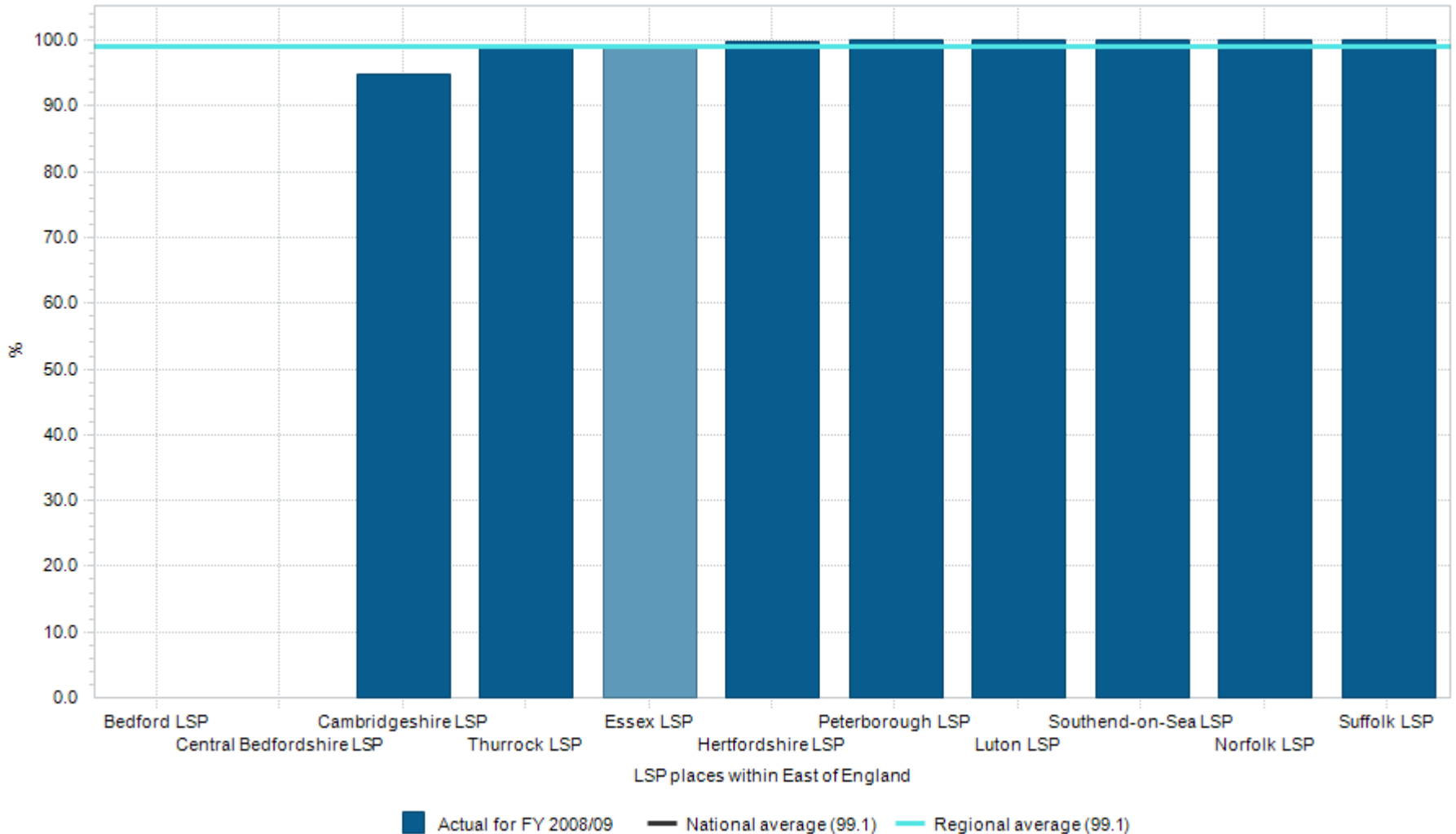

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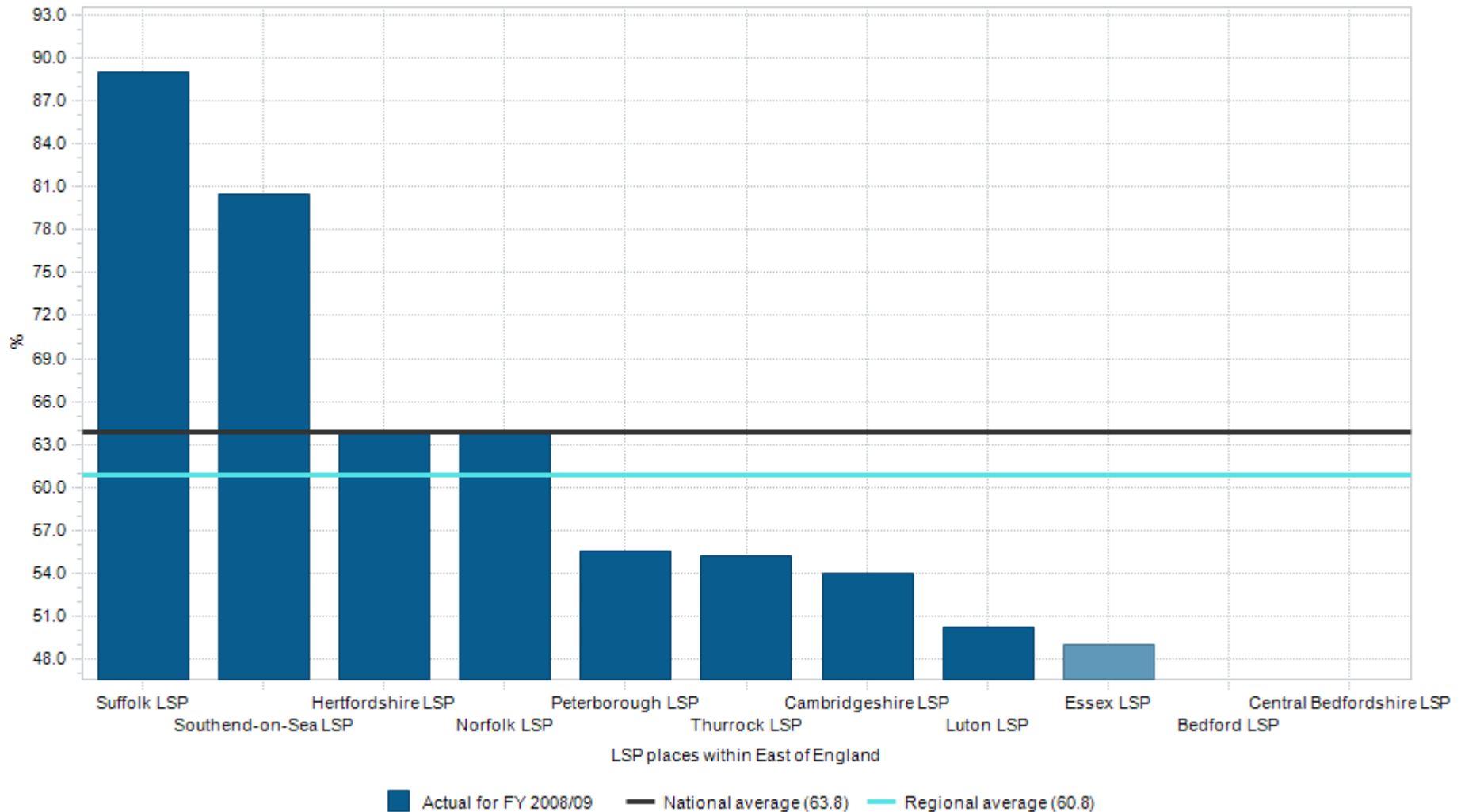
NI 067 - Percentage of child protection cases which were reviewed within required timescales - Essex LSP (22) - FY 2008/09





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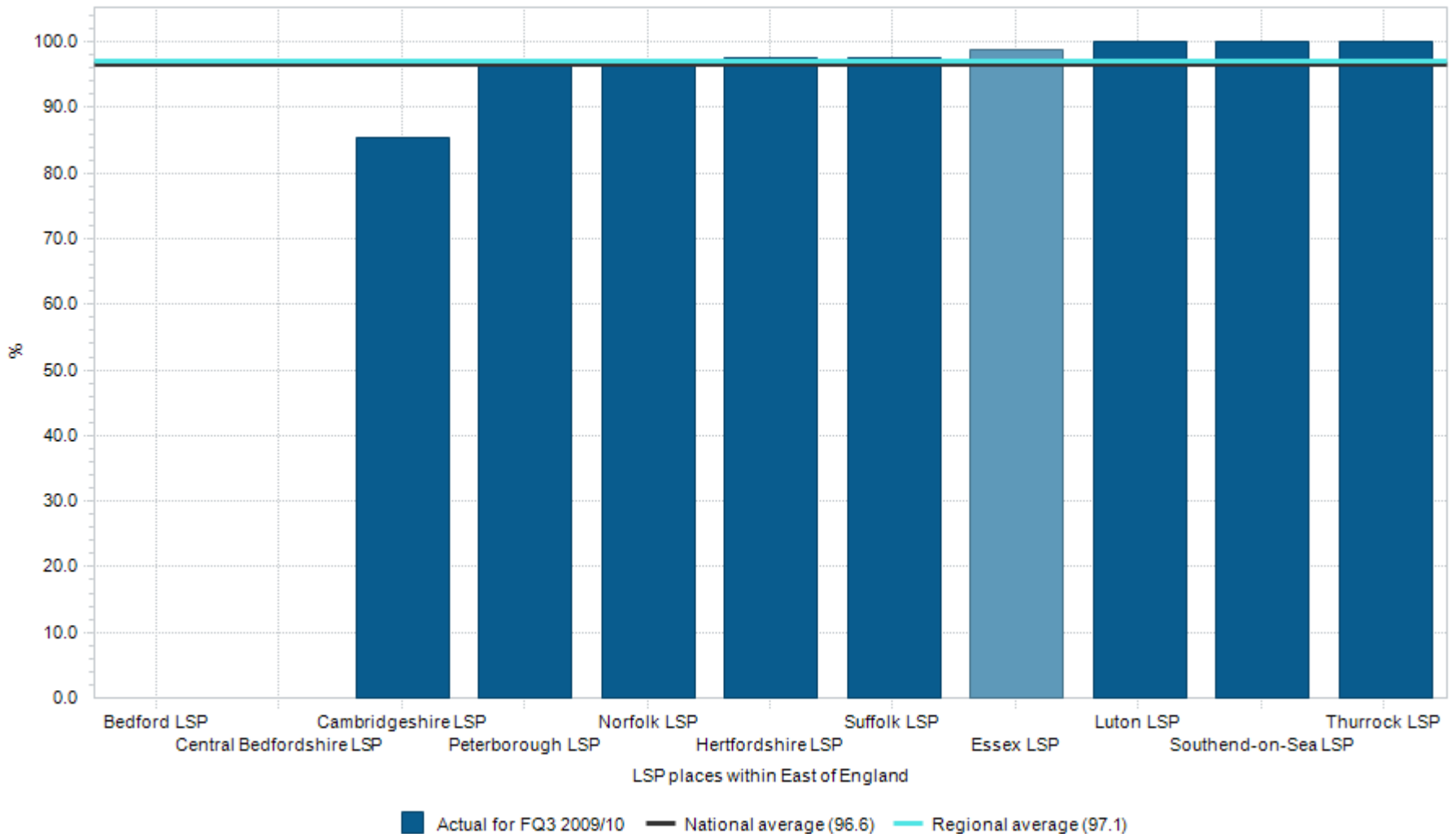

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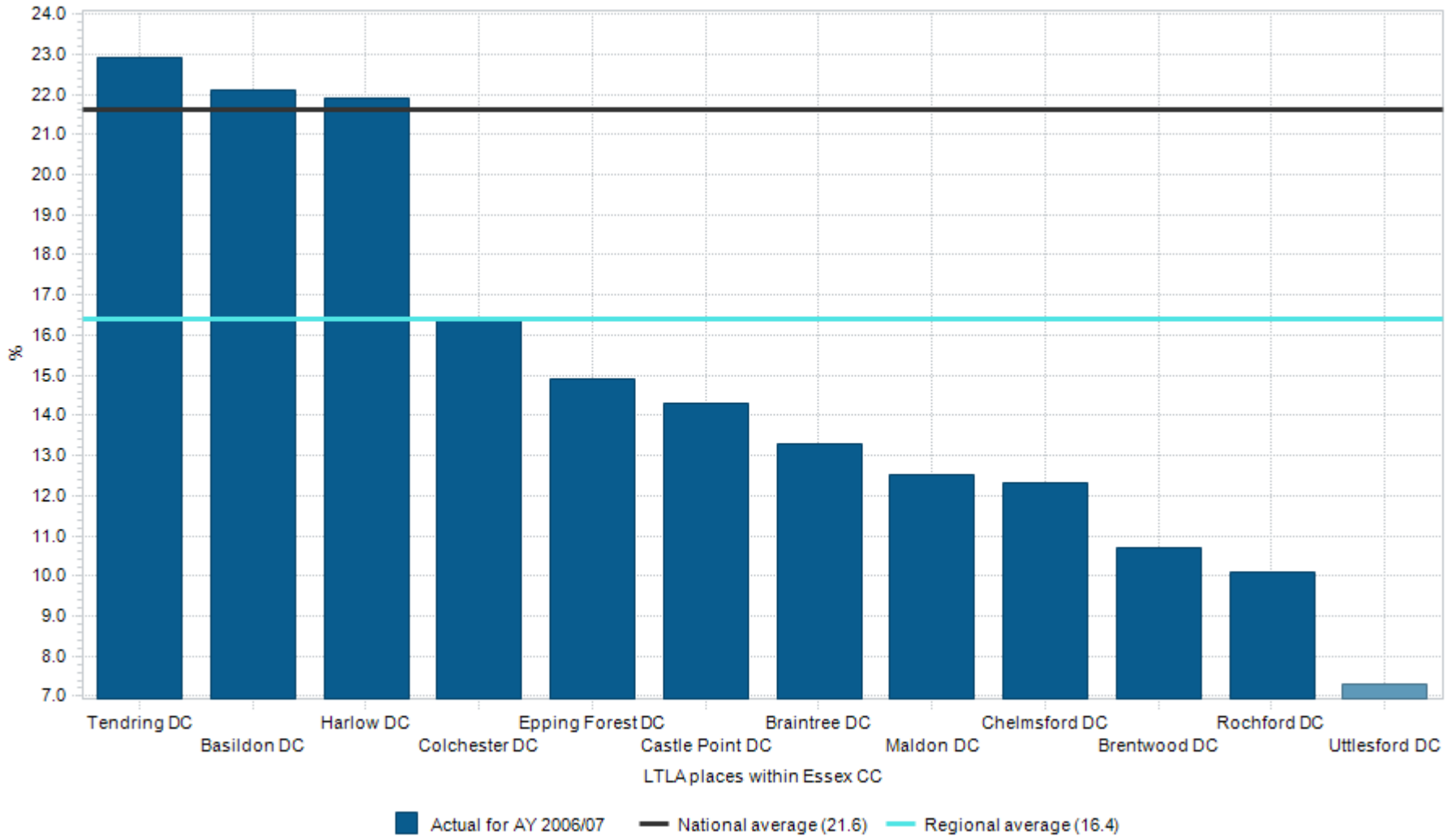
NI 139 - The extent to which older people receive the support they need to live independently at home - Castle Point DC (22UE)

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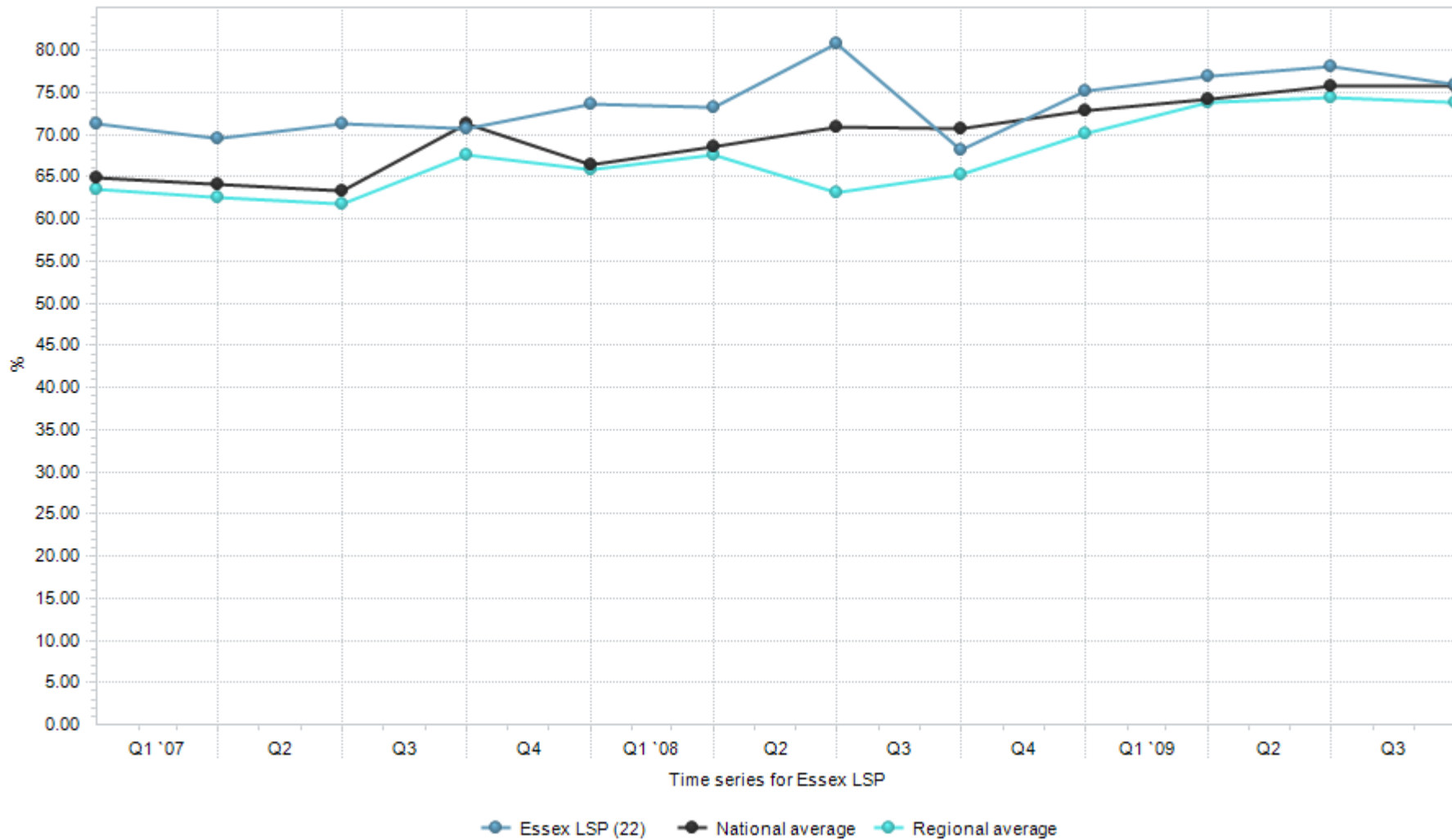
NI 139 - The extent to which older people receive the support they need to live independently at home - Essex LSP (22) - CY 2008





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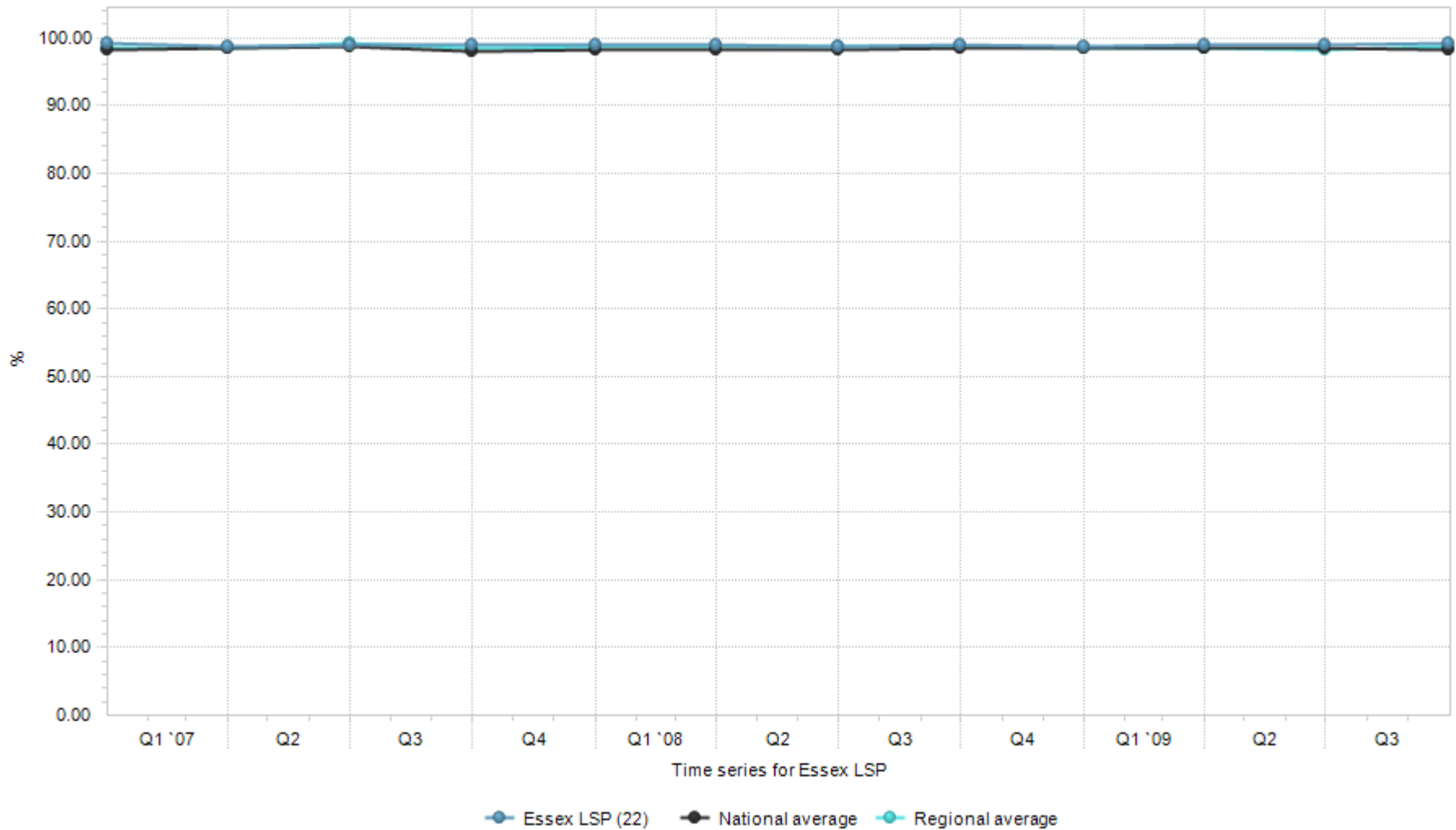
NI 141 - Percentage of vulnerable people achieving independent living - Essex LSP (22) - FQ3 2006/07 to FQ2 2009/10





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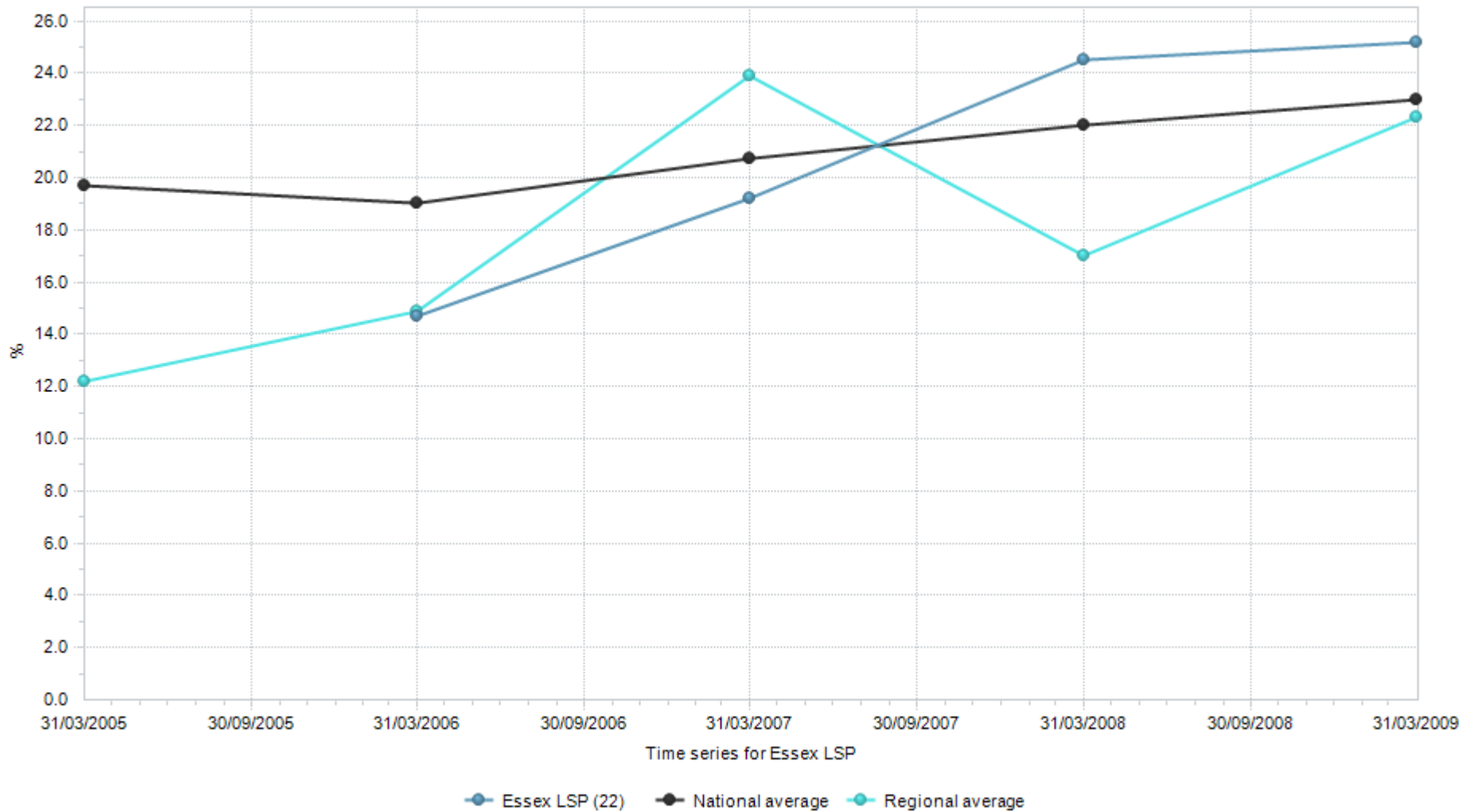

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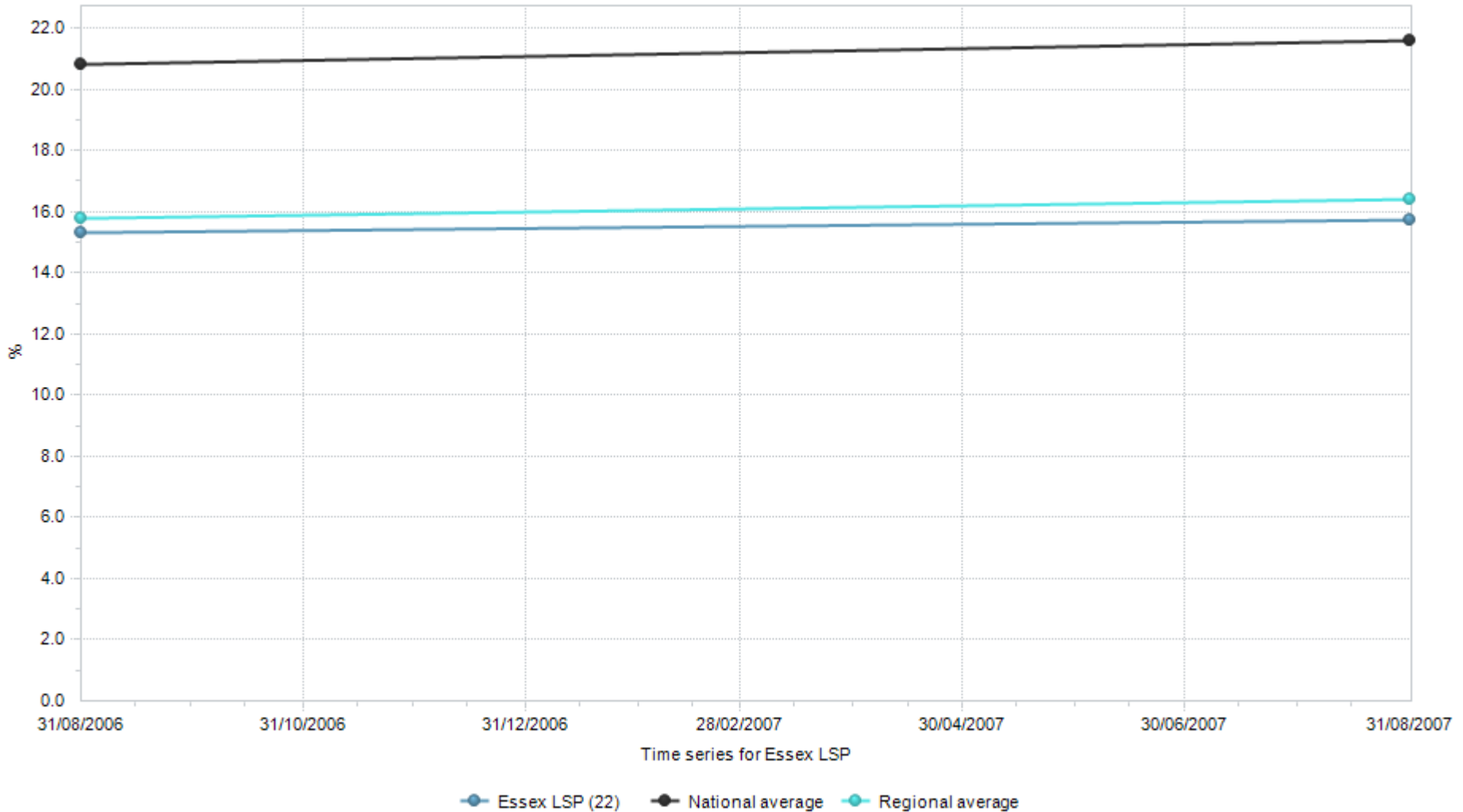

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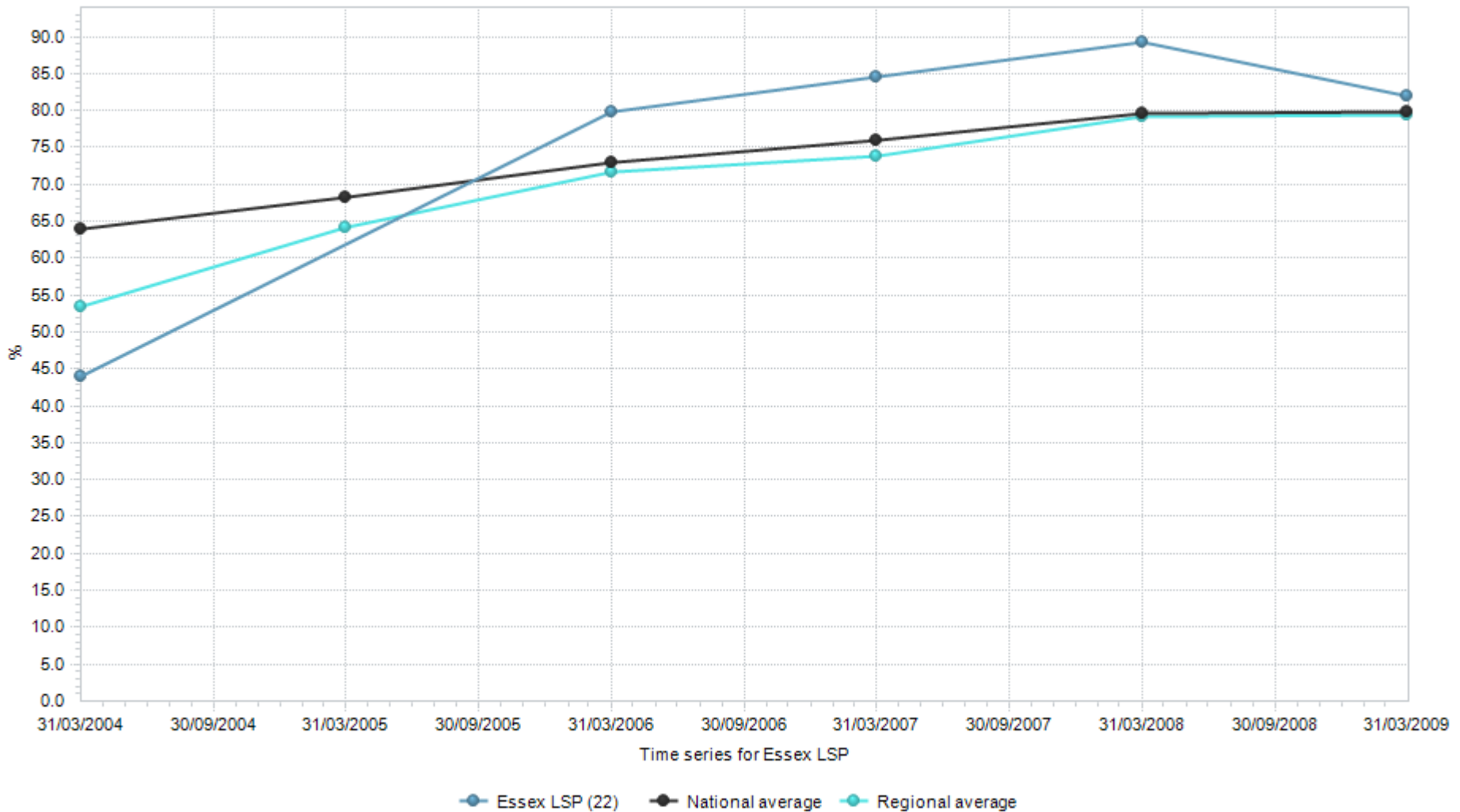
NI 116 - Proportion of children in poverty - Essex LSP (22) - AY 2005/06 to AY 2006/07





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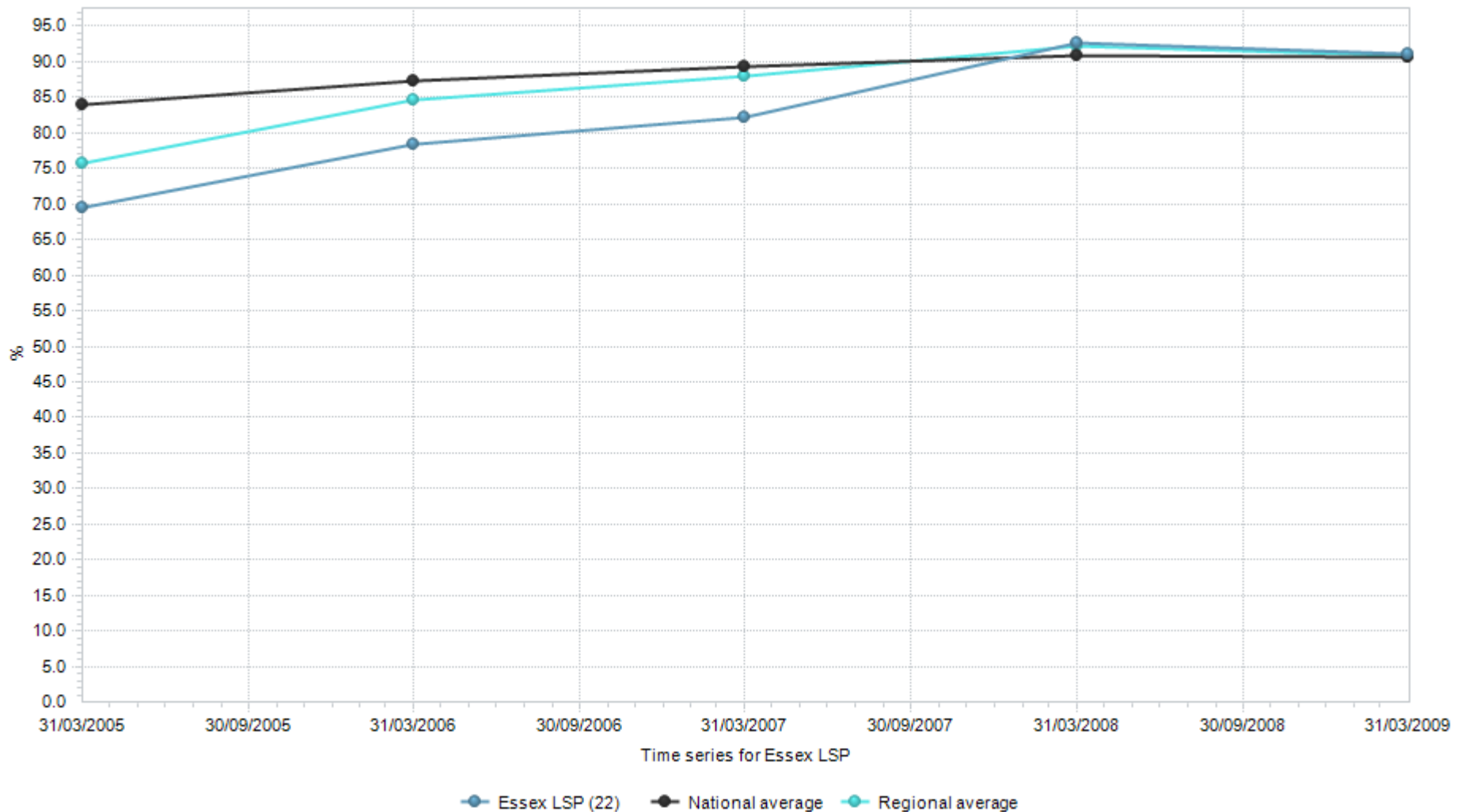

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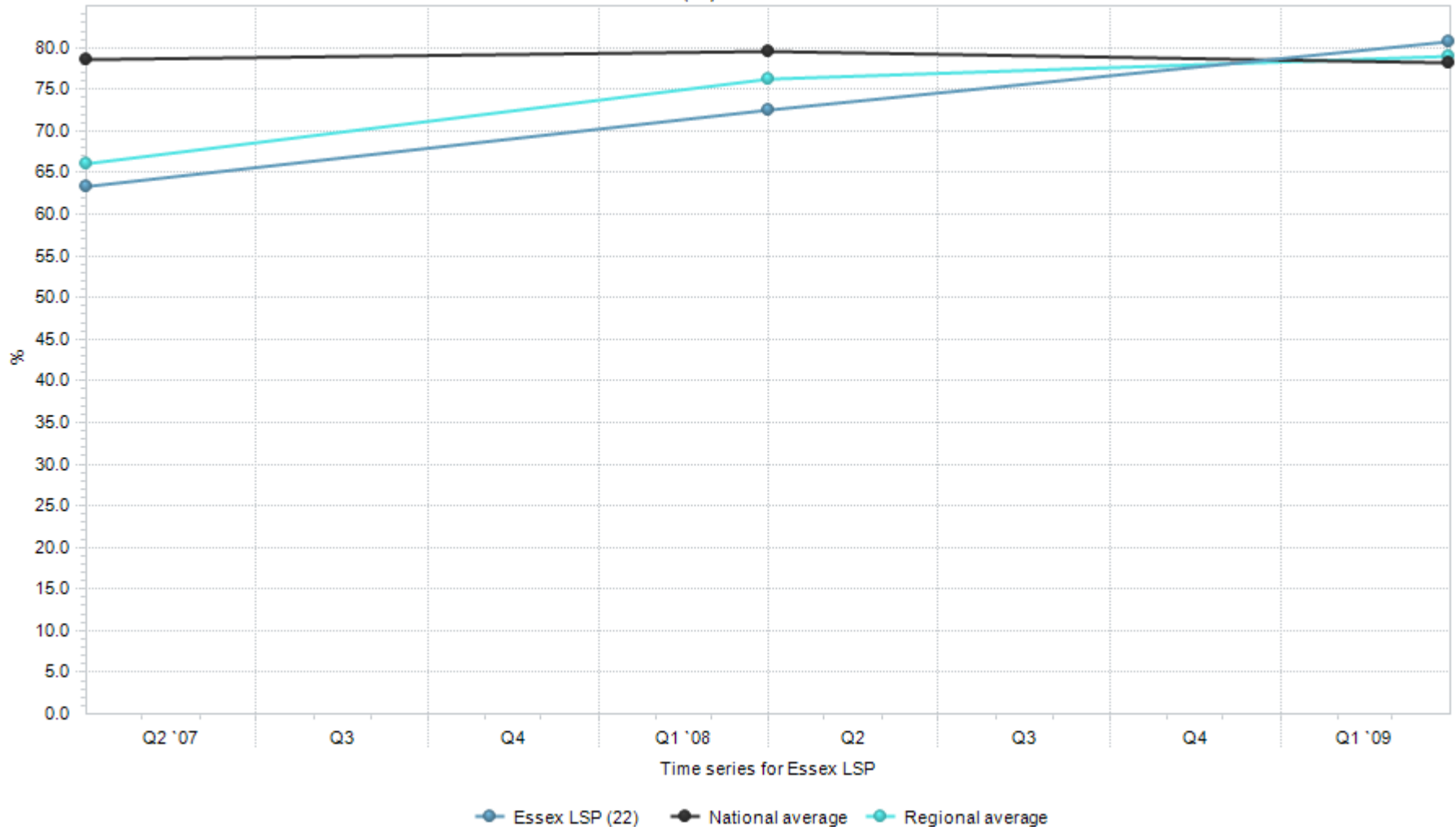

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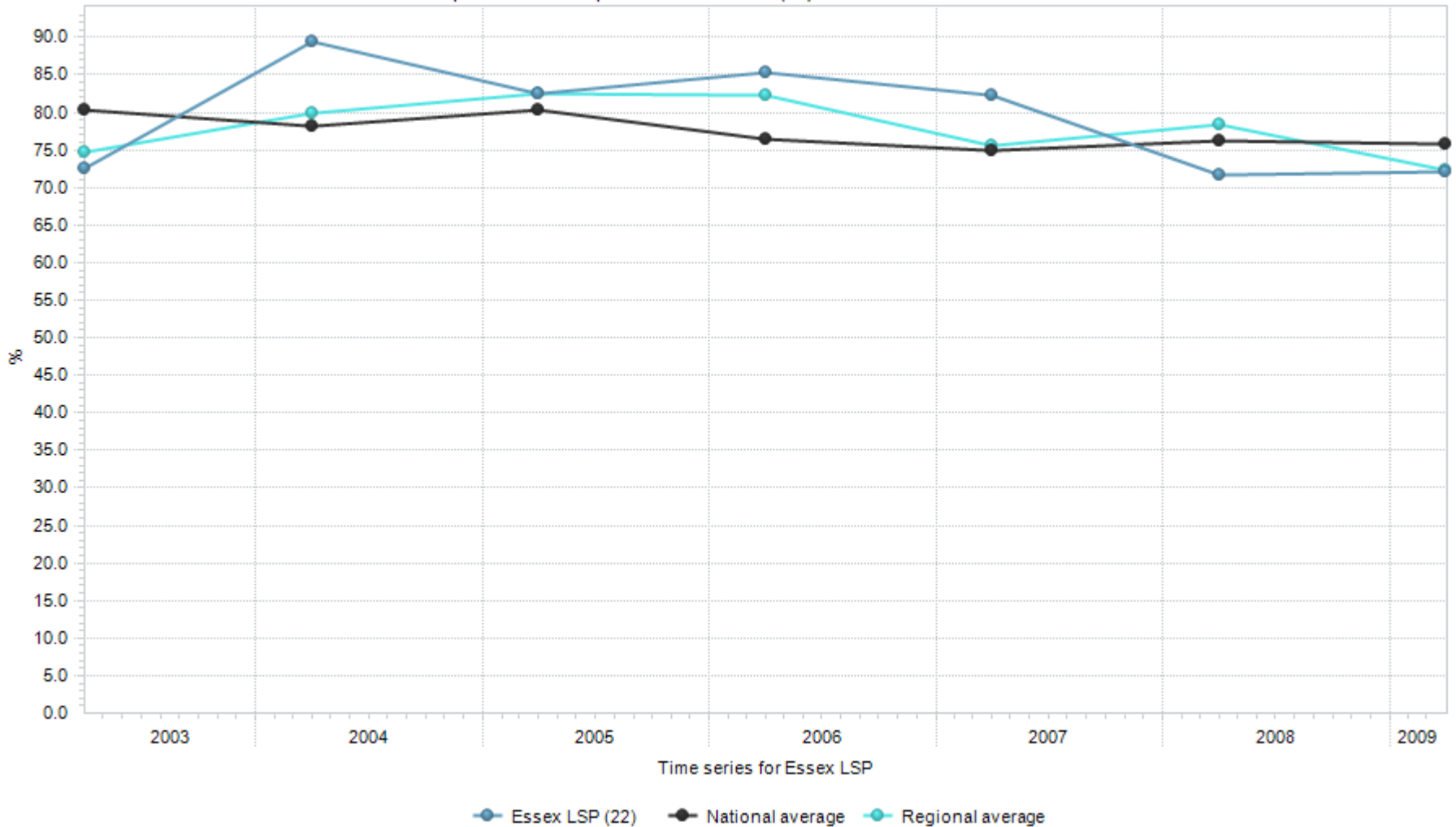
NI 060 - Percentage of core assessments for children's social care that were carried out within 35 working days of their commencement.

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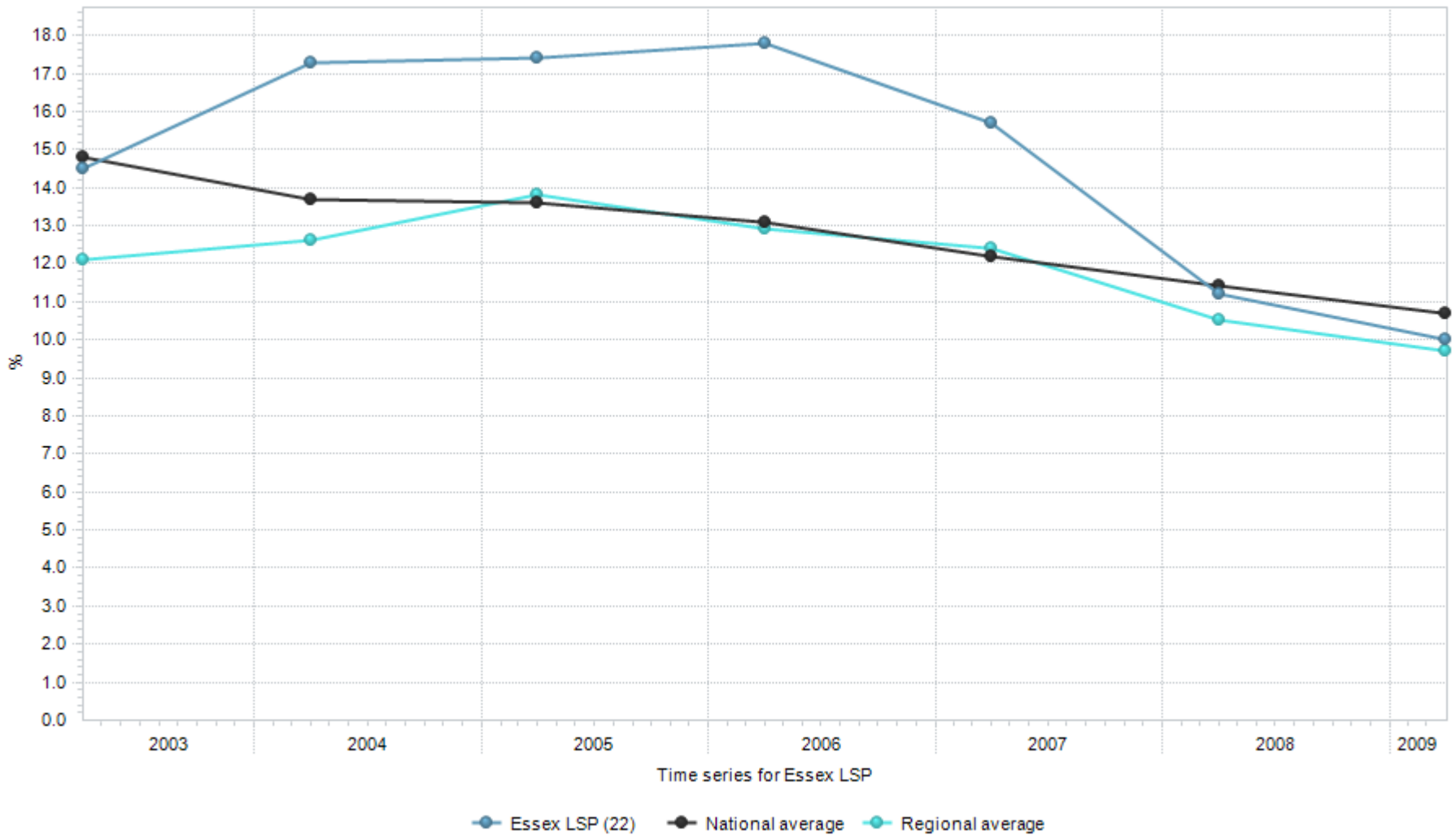

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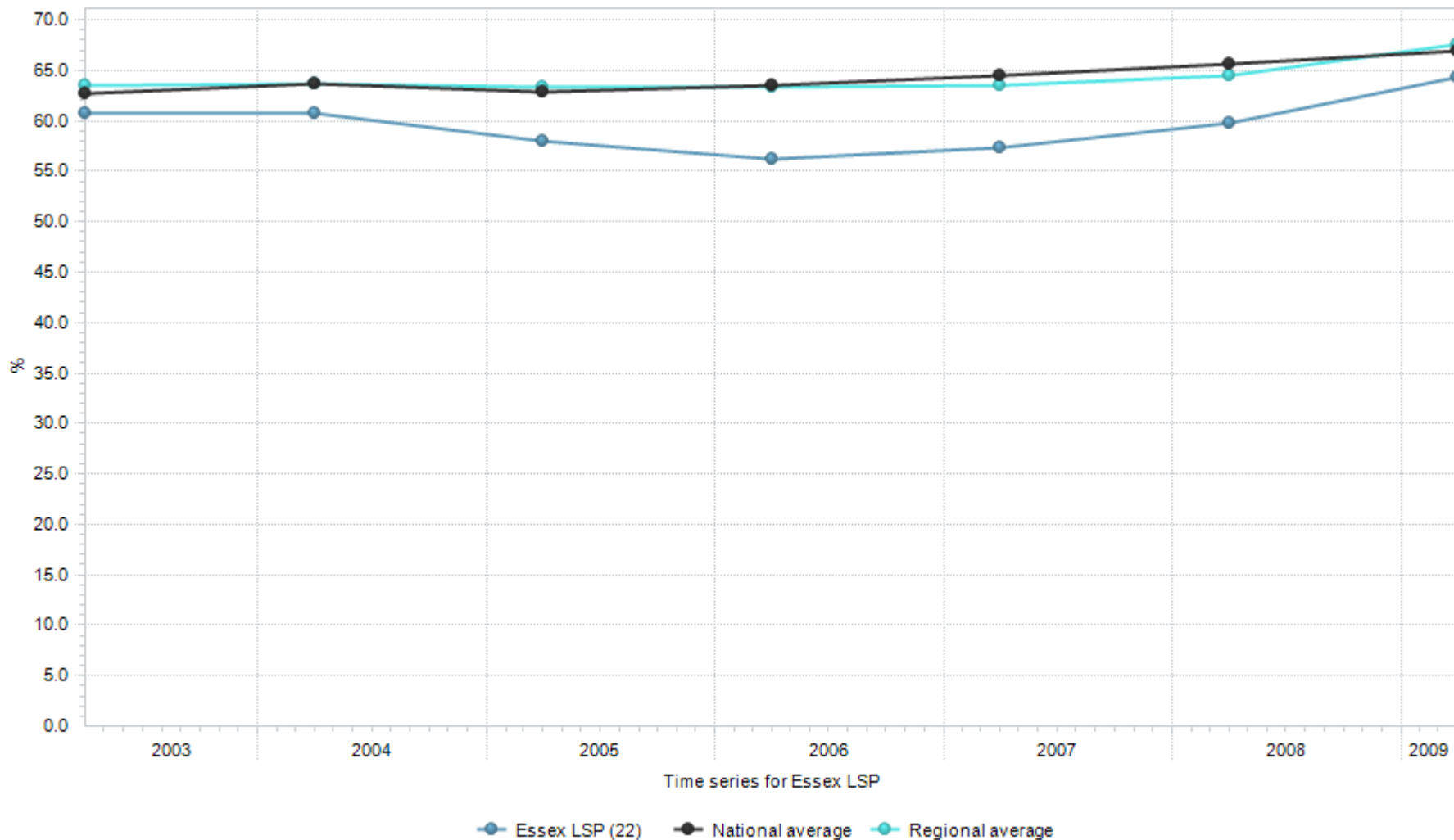
NI 062 - Stability of placements of looked after children: number of placements - Essex LSP (22) - FY 2002/03 to FY 2008/09





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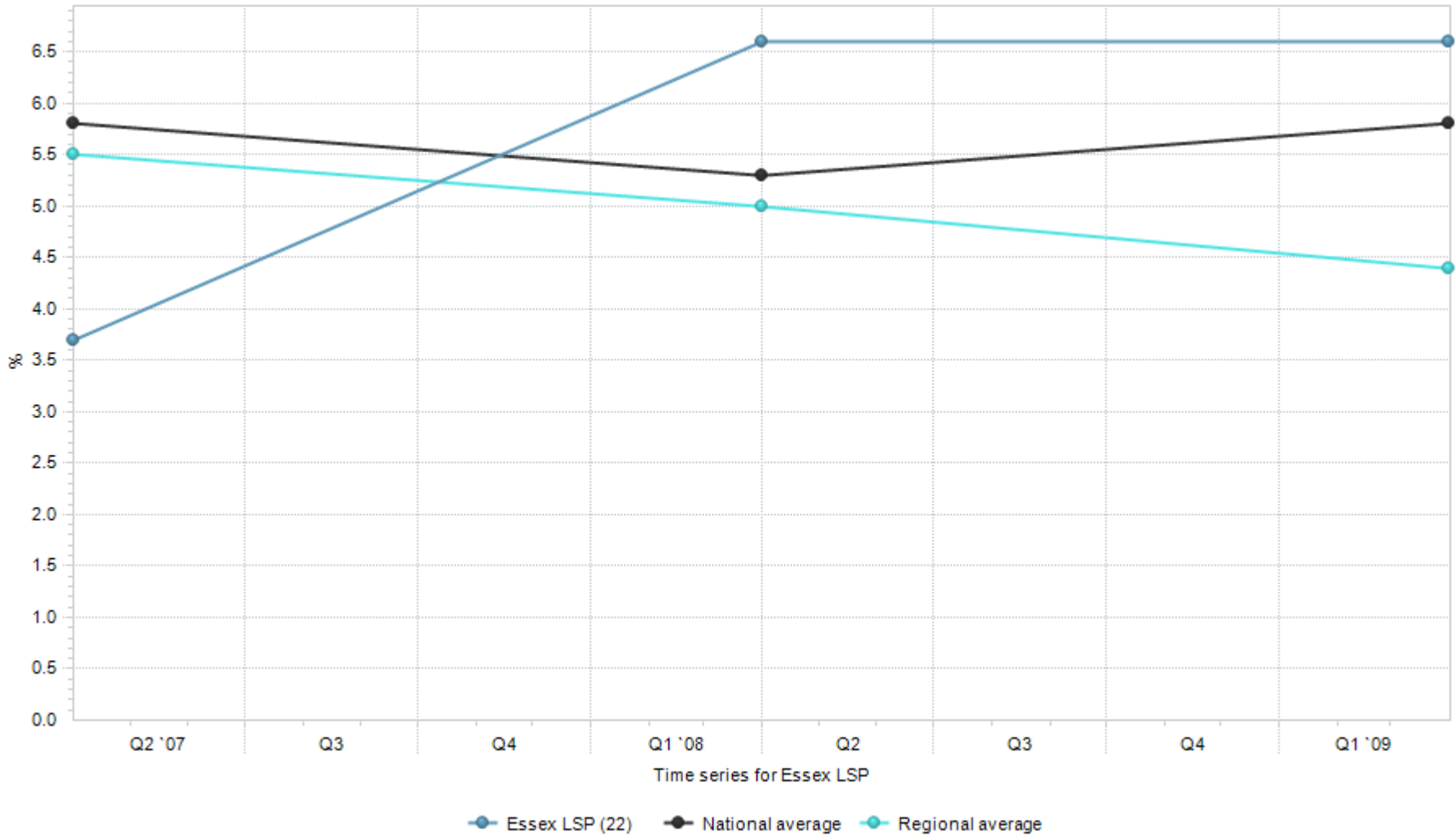

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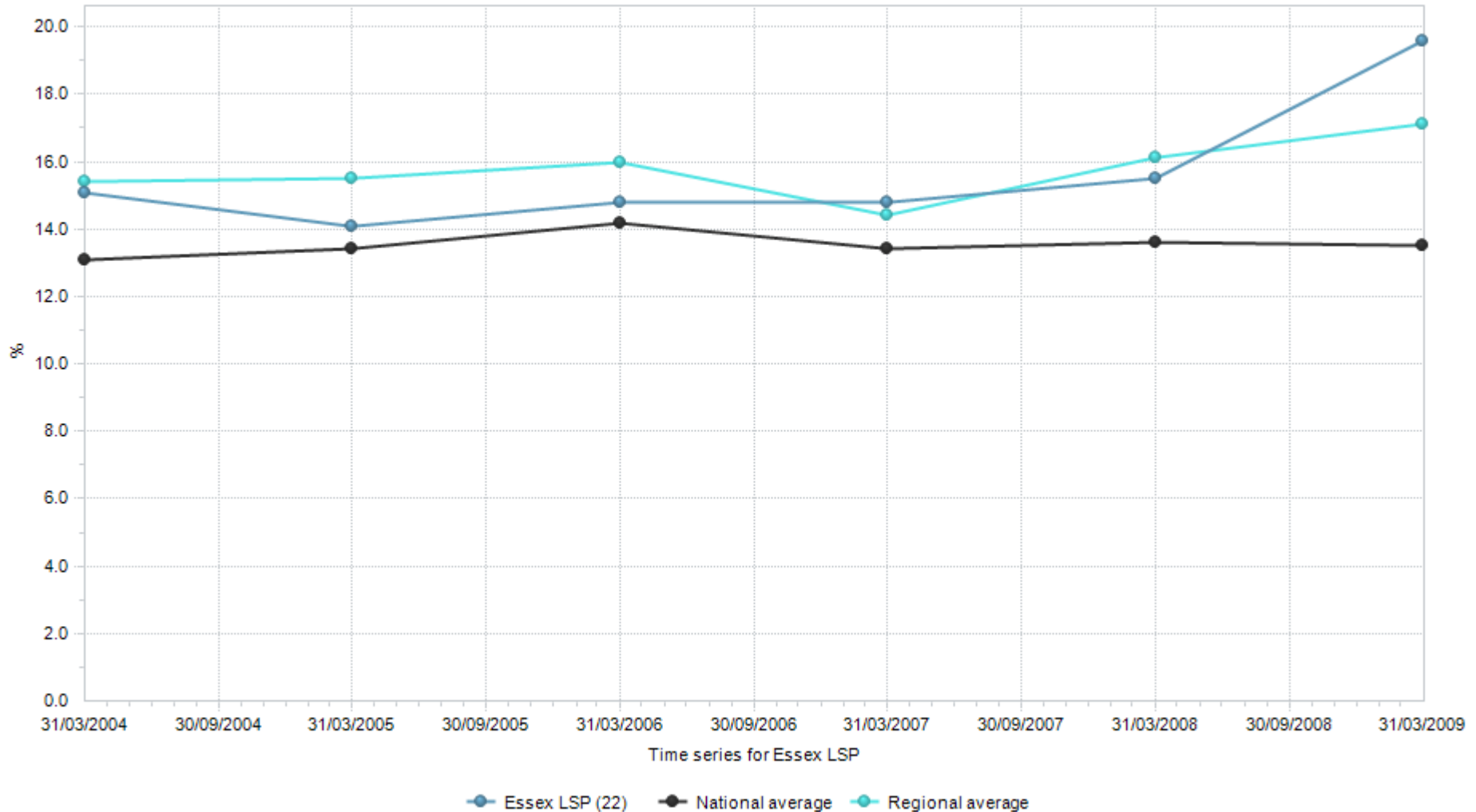

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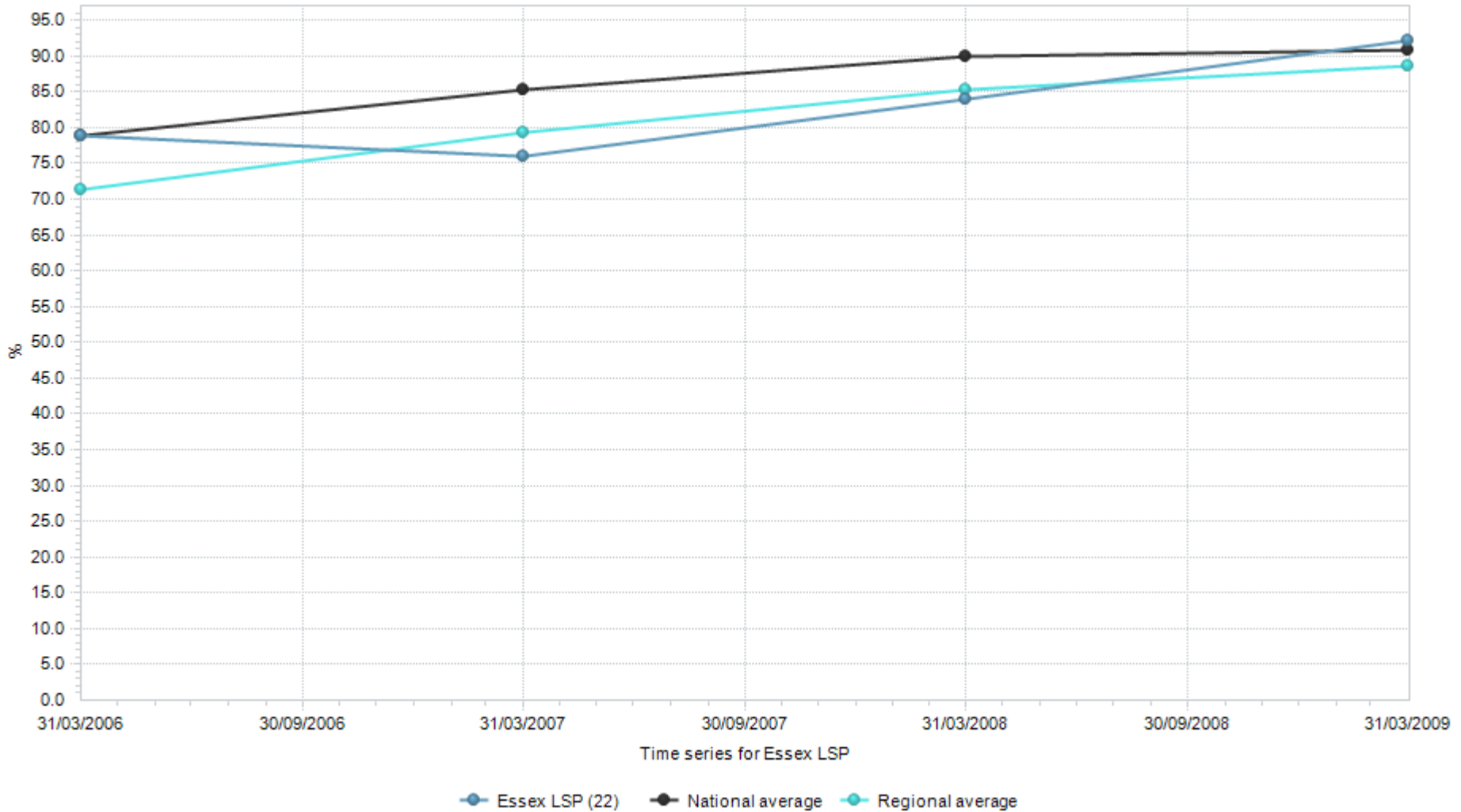
NI 065 - Percentage of children becoming the subject of Child Protection Plan for a second or subsequent time - Essex LSP (22)

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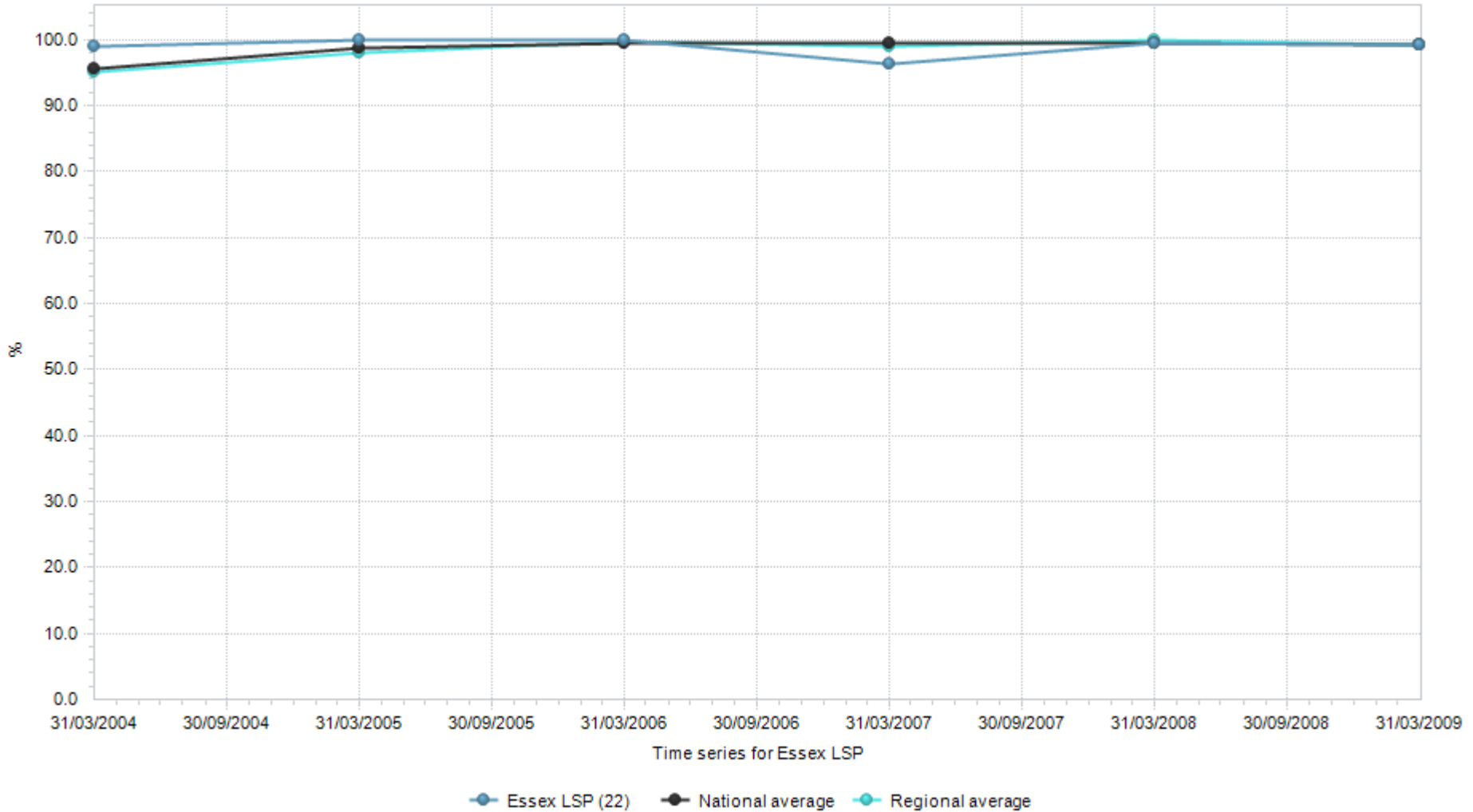

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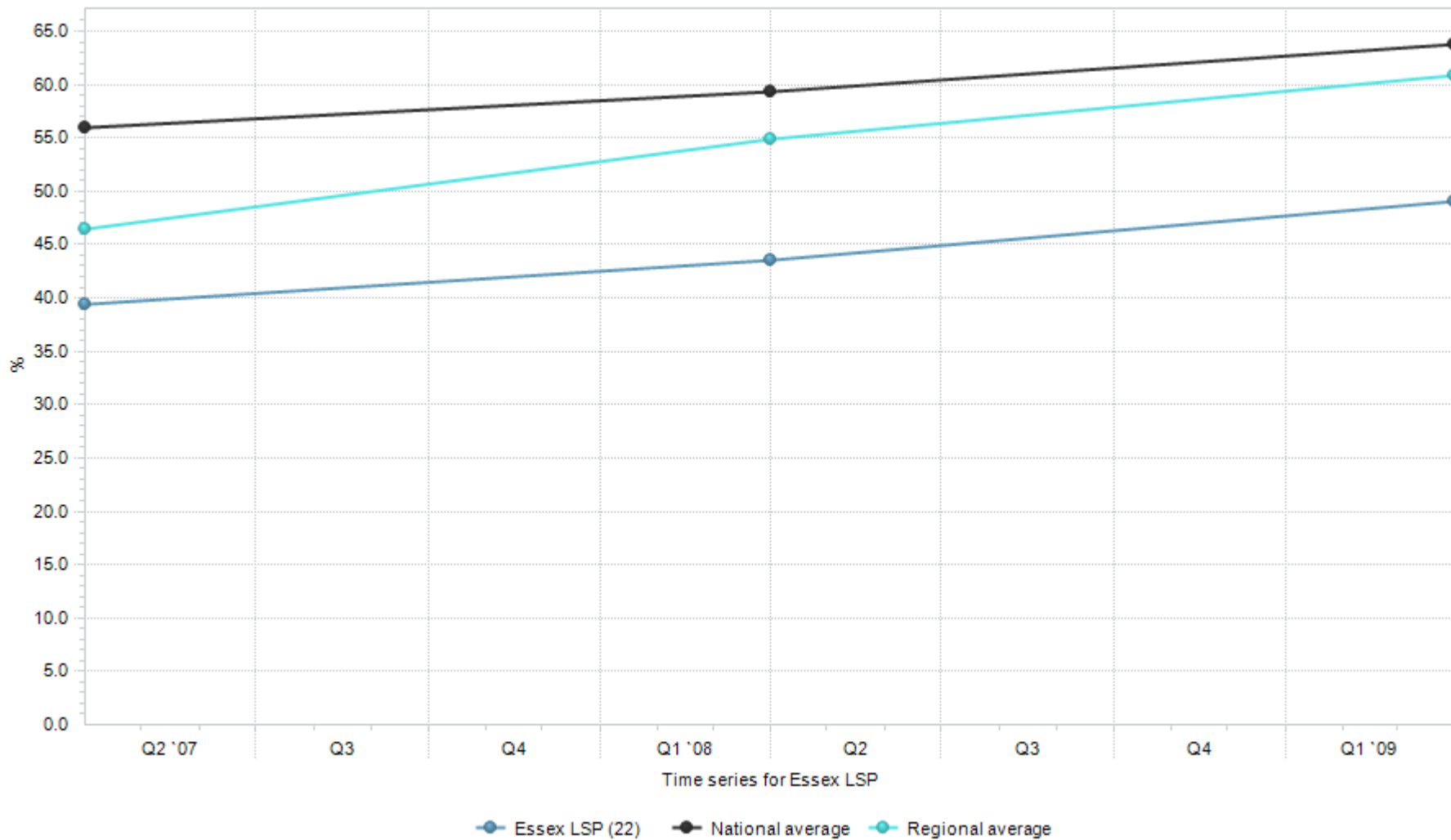
NI 067 - Percentage of child protection cases which were reviewed within required timescales - Essex LSP (22) - FY 2003/04 to FY 2008/09





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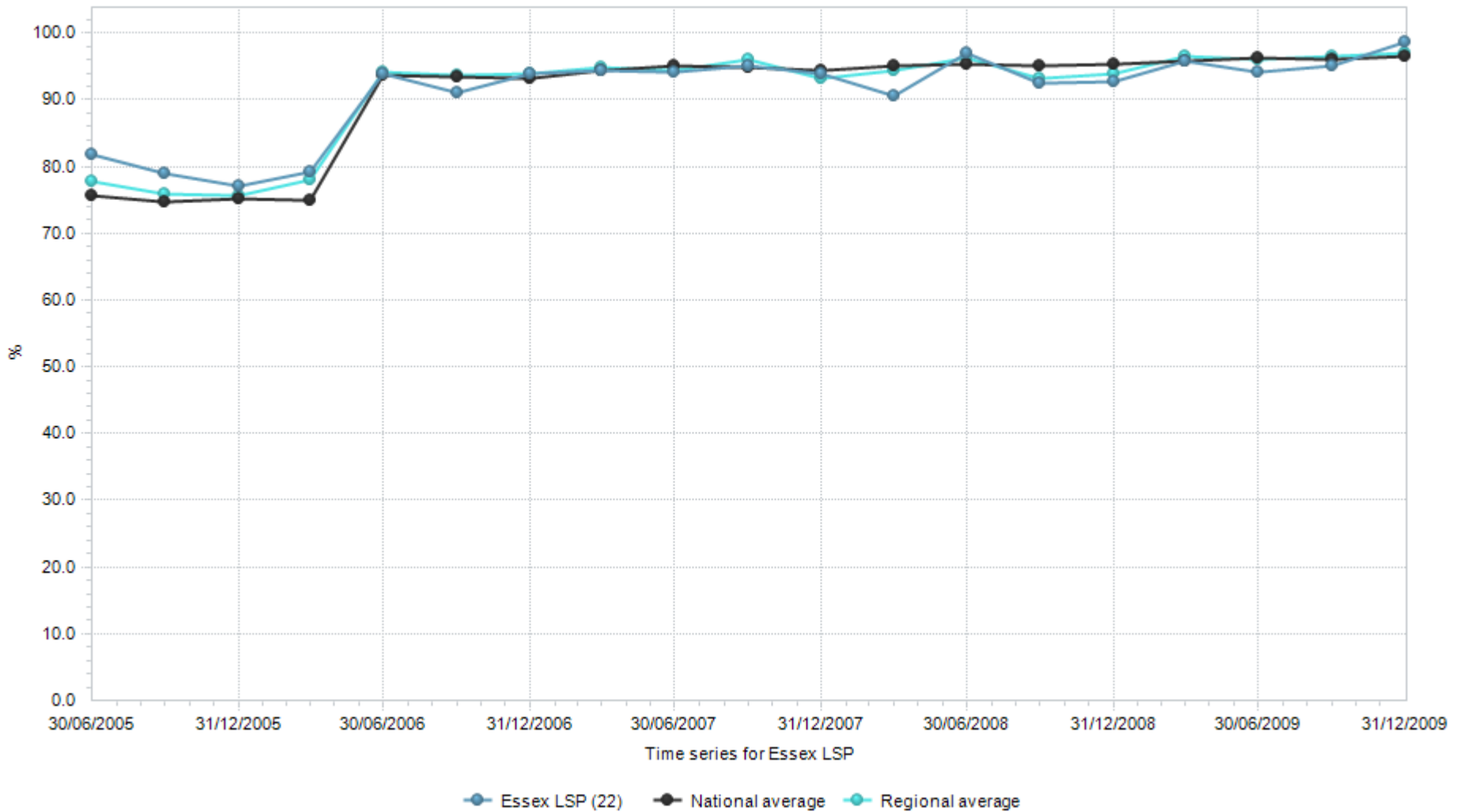
